#### About this Bulletin

The Directorate of Economics & Statistics constantly monitors the consumer prices in the State through 142 centers (74 in urban areas & 68 in rural areas) spread throughout the State. This activity has recently been upgraded and also computerised. It is now proposed to bring out a monthly bulletin indicating not only the prices prevailing in the State but also indicate some major Economic Indicators in the State and at the National level. A brief summary of these findings is placed below.

#### Summary

#### 1. Prices

- The Consumer Price Indices compiled separately for urban and rural areas of the State for February, 2010 (Prov.) were 165.3 and 172.2 respectively, as against 166.6 & 173.8 during January, 2010
- The decline in index during February, 2010 was mainly due to decrease in the prices of Turdal in food group in both urban and rural areas.
- The average prices of the five main commodities in the State during February, 2010 (P) were,
  - 1) Rice : Rs.19.90 (Rs.18.52) in urban areas and Rs. 17.62 (Rs.16.31) in rural areas
  - 2) Wheat : Rs. 14.09 (Rs.12.64) in urban areas and Rs. 11.23 (Rs.9.95) in rural areas
  - 3) Tur Dal : Rs. 73.32 (Rs.50.00) in urban areas and Rs. 72.30 (Rs.49.11) in rural areas
  - 4) Sugar : Rs. 40.02 (Rs.22.01) in urban areas and Rs. 39.79 (Rs.21.92) in rural areas
  - 5) Groundnut Oil : Rs. 73.72 (Rs.69.61) in urban areas and Rs. 75.02 (Rs.73.25) in rural areas

*Note : Figures in brackets are prices for the corresponding period of the previous year.*
- The inflation rate on the basis of CPI, prevailing in the State during February, 2010 (P) (over corresponding month of the previous year) was 15.9 per cent in Urban areas and 16.9 per cent in Rural areas.
- The inflation rate based on All India Wholesale Price Index (WPI) was 8.6 per cent during January, 2010. This rate was as high as 14.5 per cent for Primary Articles.
- The All-India CPI for Industrial Workers, CPI (IW) increased by 16.2 per cent during January, 2010 over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- During the same period, the All-India CPI for Rural Labourers and for Agricultural Labourers also increased by 17.4 per cent.

#### 2. Economic Indicators

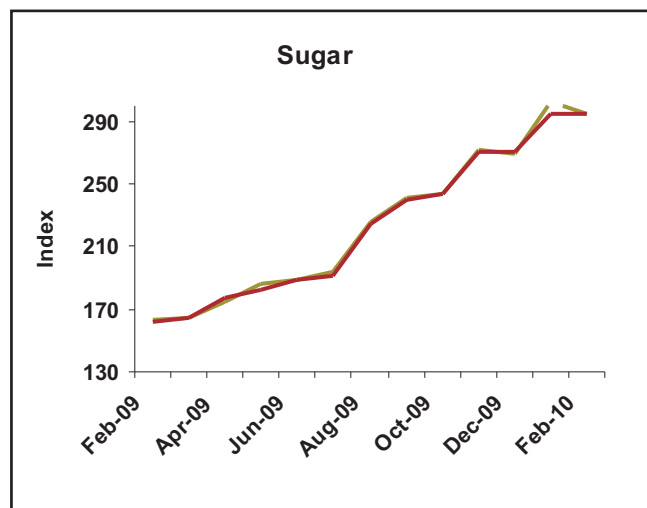
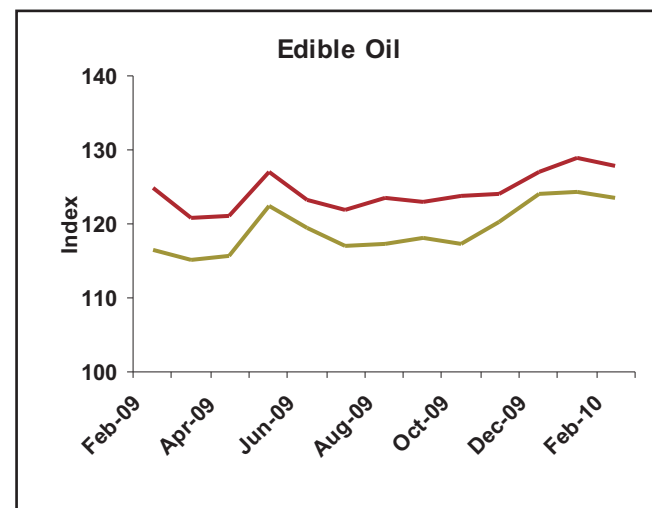
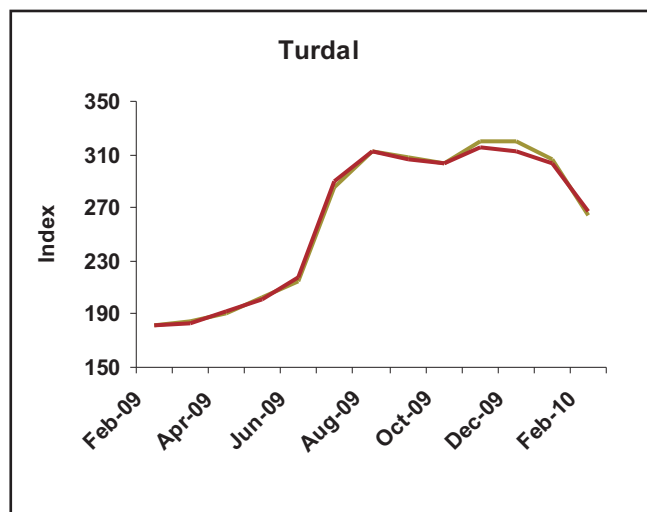
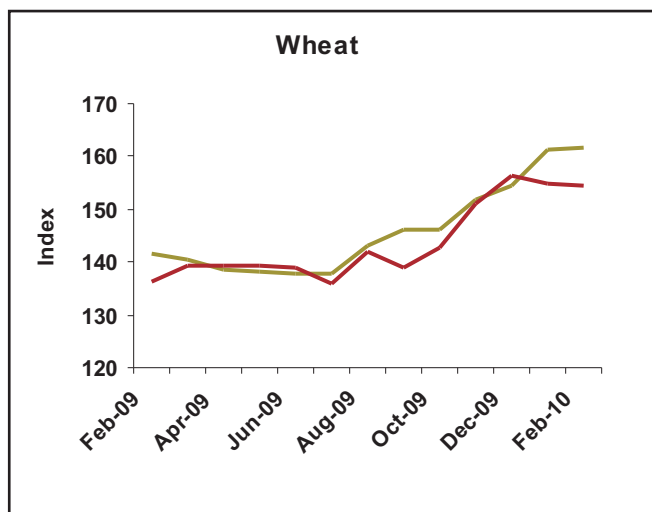
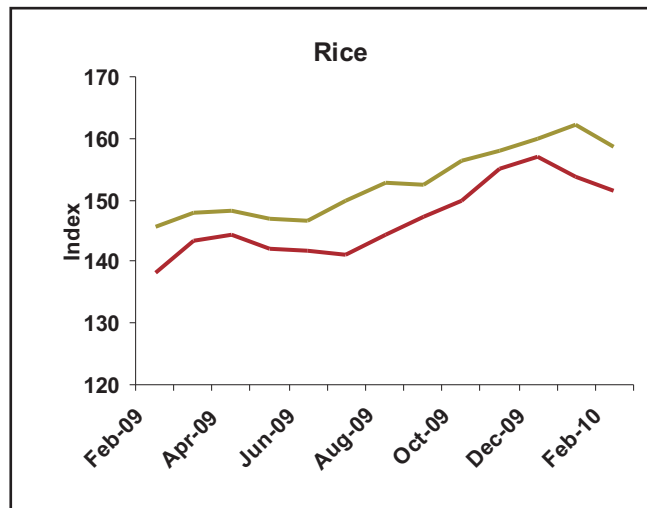
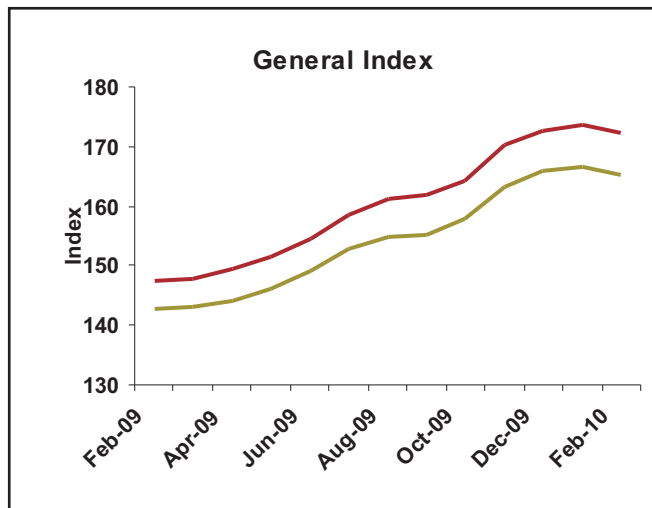
- All India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) during December, 2009 was 331.7, more by 16.8 per cent over the corresponding period of the previous year. During this period Manufacturing sector increased by 18.5 per cent.
- The revenue receipts of the State Government during first ten months of the current fiscal were Rs. 64,391 crore, whereas the revenue expenditure was Rs. 61,857 crore.
- The broad money supply (M3) in the economy as on February 12, 2010 was more by 16.4 per cent than that was prevailing during the corresponding day of the previous year.
