About this Bulletin

The Directorate of Economics & Statistics constantly monitors the consumer prices in the State through 142 centers (74 in urban areas & 68 in rural areas) spread throughout the State. A bulletin indicating the prices prevailing in the State and some major economic indicators of the State and also at the National Level is published in this bulletin on a monthly basis. A summary of these findings is placed below.


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Summary

1. Prices

- The Consumer Price Indices compiled separately for urban and rural areas of the State for May, 2011 were 182.50 (P) and 191.83 (P) respectively, as against 180.04 & 189.41 during April, 2011 .
- The inflation rate based on state CPI during May, 2011 was 8.2 per cent and 10.8 per cent in urban and rural areas respectively.
- The increase in index during the month was mainly due to increase in the prices of jowar, milk & groundnut oil in food group and the prices of pan leaf, country & foreign liquor in Pan,Supari and Tobacco Group in both urban & rural areas.
- The inflation rate based on All-India Wholesale Price Index (WPI) was 8.7 per cent (P) during April, 2011. The food inflation during the month was 8.7 per cent.
- During April, 2011 the All-India CPI for Industrial Workers, CPI (IW) increased by 9.4 per cent over the corresponding period of the previous year.

2. Economic Indicators

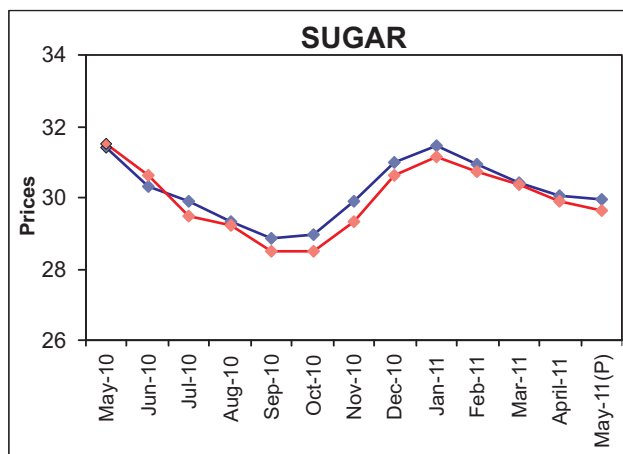
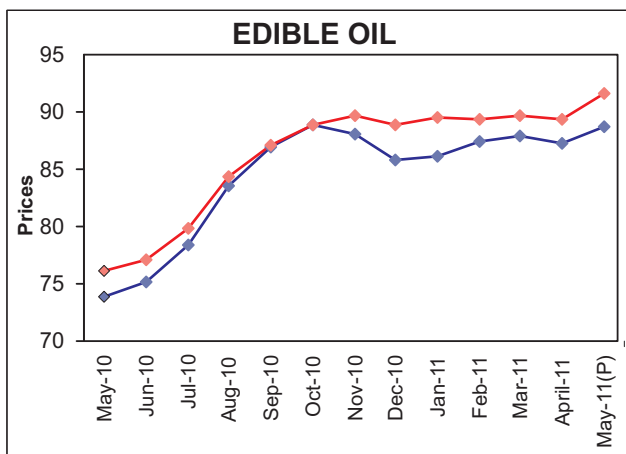
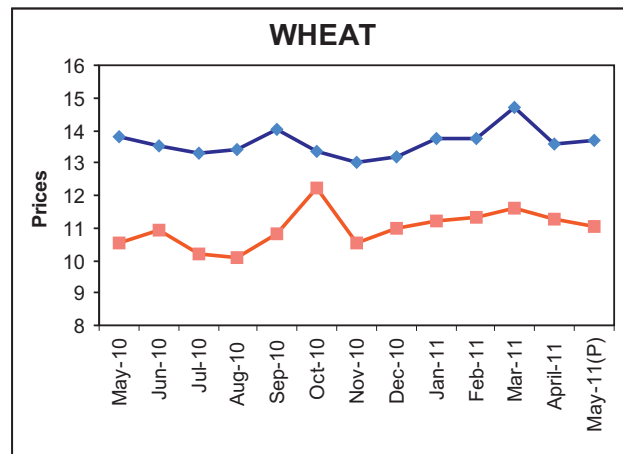
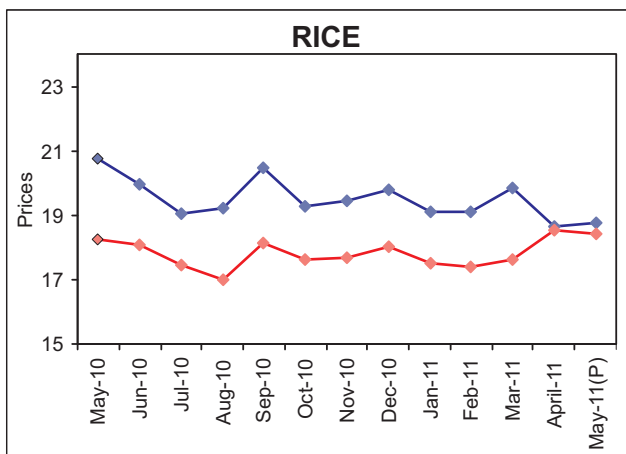
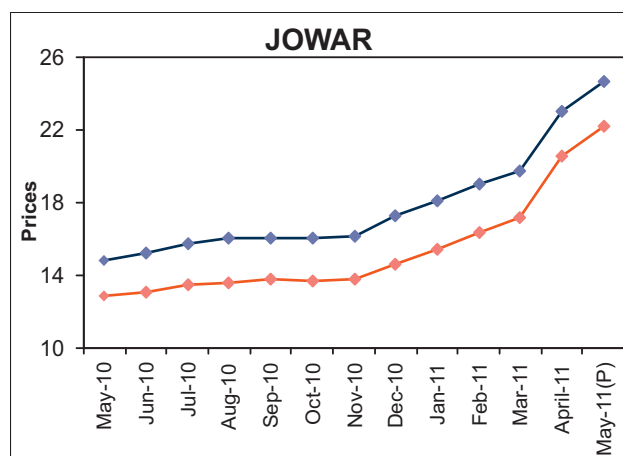
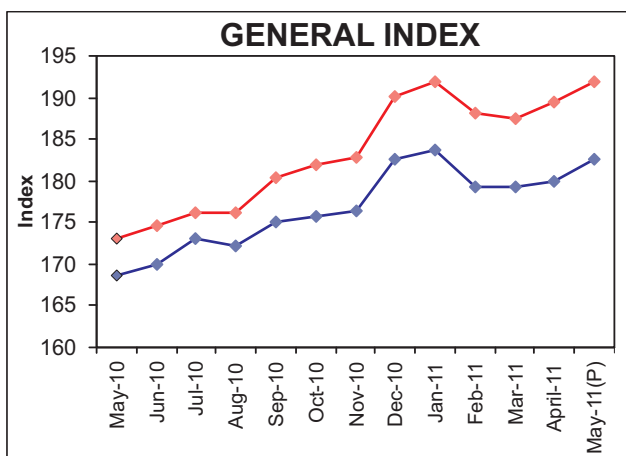
- All India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) during March, 2011 was 401.2, more by 7.3 per cent while the Index of Manufacturing sector was 438.5 more by 7.9 per cent over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- The broad money supply (M₃) in the economy as on 6th May, 2011 was more by 16.9 per cent than that was prevailing on the corresponding day of the previous year.
- The revenue receipts of the State Government during 2010-11 upto March, 2011 were ₹ 103,475 crore, of which tax revenue was ₹ 85,356 crore .
- The revenue expenditure of the State Government during 2010-11 upto March, 2011 was ₹ 103,700 crore of which, plan expenditure was ₹ 17,612 crore.
- As on May 30, 2011 Sensex of Bombay Stock Exchange was 18,232 and Nifty of National Stock Exchange was 5,473.
