About this Bulletin

The Directorate of Economics & Statistics constantly monitors the consumer prices in the State through 142 centers (74 in urban areas & 68 in rural areas) spread throughout the State. A bulletin indicating the prices prevailing in the State and some major economic indicators of the State and also at the National Level is published on a monthly basis. A summary of these findings is placed below.

Summary

1. Prices

- The Consumer Price Indices compiled separately for urban and rural areas of the State for September, 2010 were 173.6 (P) and 179.2 (P) respectively, as against 172.2 & 176.2 during August, 2010 .
- The inflation rate based on CPI, prevailing in the State during September, 2010 (over corresponding month of the previous year) was 11.9 per cent (P) in Urban areas and 10.8 per cent (P) in Rural areas.
- The increase in index during the month was mainly due to increase in the prices of rice & wheat in rural areas and groundnut oil, milk, onion in both urban and rural areas.
- The increase in prices of cigarette and foreign liquor in urban and bidi, tobacco and Country liquor in rural areas from pan, supari and tobacco group has also impact on the General Index.

The average prices of the five main commodities in the State during September, 2010 (P) were

- 1) Rice : ₹ 19.74 (₹ 18.20) in urban areas and ₹ 17.54 (₹ 16.19) in rural areas
- 2) Wheat : ₹ 13.28 (₹ 12.14) in urban areas and ₹ 10.19 (₹ 9.15) in rural areas
- 3) Tur Dal : ₹ 66.07 (₹ 85.21) in urban areas and ₹ 66.19 (₹ 82.86) in rural areas
- 4) Sugar : ₹ 28.84 (₹ 32.63) in urban areas and ₹ 28.50 (₹ 32.42) in rural areas
- 5) Groundnut Oil : ₹ 86.99 (₹ 70.72) in urban areas and ₹ 87.13 (₹ 72.43) in rural areas

Note : Figures in brackets are prices for the corresponding period of the previous year.

- The inflation rate based on All India Wholesale Price Index (WPI) was 8.5 per cent (P) during August, 2010. This rate was 15.8 per cent (P) for Primary Articles.
- The All-India CPI for Industrial Workers, CPI (IW) increased by 9.9 per cent during August, 2010 over the corresponding period of the previous year.

2. Economic Indicators

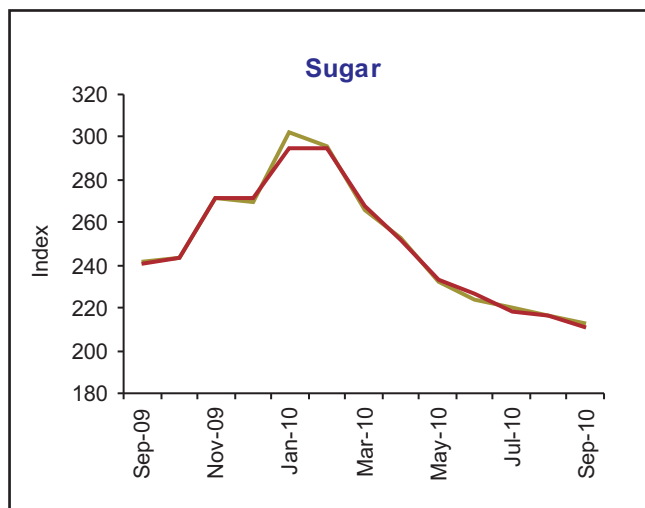
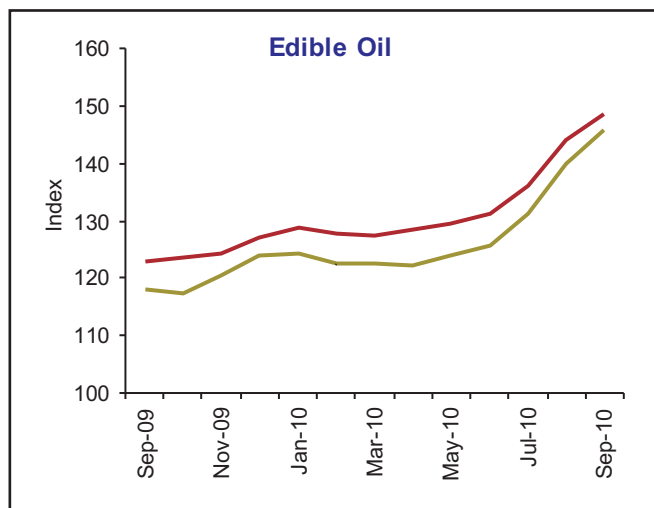
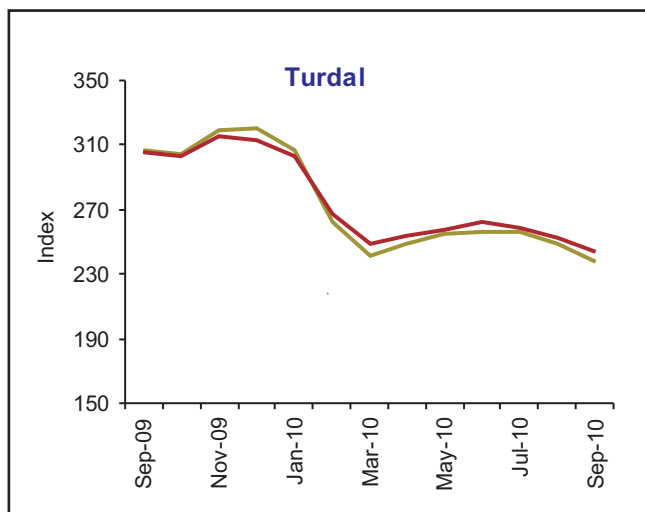
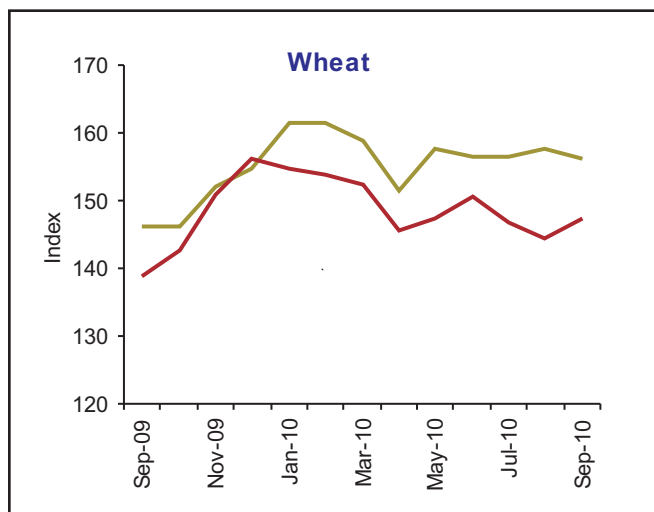
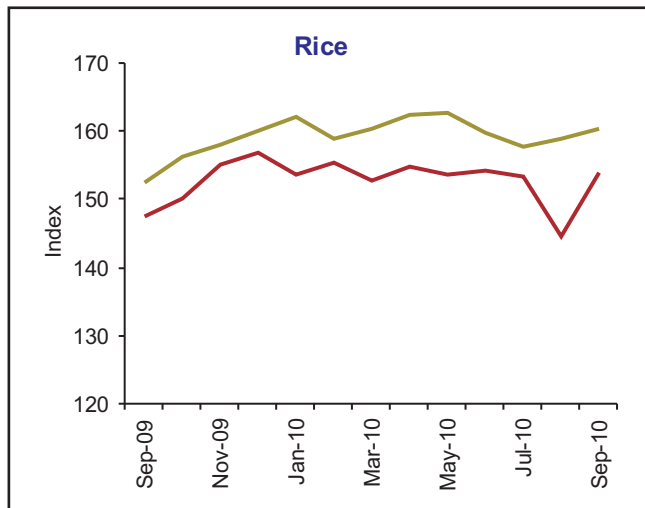
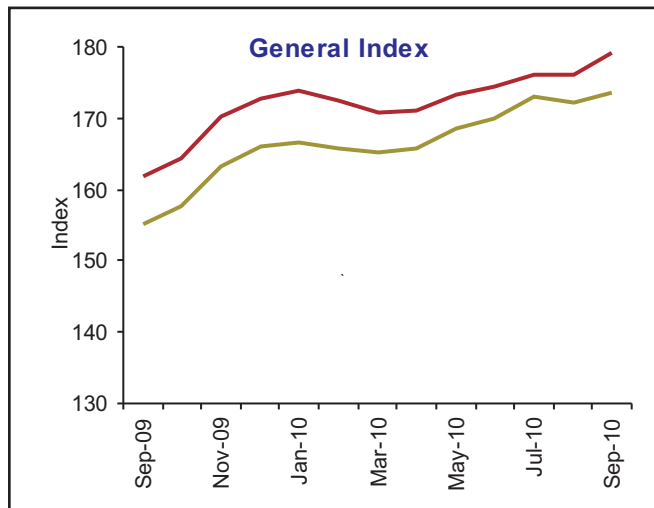
- All India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) during July, 2010 was 330.8, more by 13.8 per cent while the Index of Manufacturing sector was 360.1, more by 15.0 per cent over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- The broad money supply (M₃) in the economy as on September 10, 2010 was more by 15.2 per cent than that was prevailing on the corresponding day of the previous year.
- The revenue receipts of the State Government during 2010-11 upto August, 2010 was ₹ 37,090 crore of which tax revenue was ₹ 31,954 crore .
- The revenue expenditure of the State Government during 2010-11 upto August, 2010 was ₹ 33,984 crore of which plan expenditure was ₹ 2,416 crore.
- Sensex of Bombay Stock Exchange as on September 30, 2010 was 20,069 and Nifty of National Stock Exchange was 6,030.
