About this Bulletin

The Directorate of Economics & Statistics constantly monitors the consumer prices in the State through 142 centers (74 in urban areas & 68 in rural areas) spread throughout the State. A bulletin indicating the prices prevailing in the State and some major economic indicators of the State and also at the National Level is published on a monthly basis. A summary of these findings is placed below.

Summary

1. Prices

- The Consumer Price Indices compiled separately for urban and rural areas of the State for July, 2010 were 173.3 (P) and 176.5 (P) respectively, as against 170.1 & 174.5 during June, 2010. The increase in index during the month was mainly due to increase in the prices of Groundnut & Refined oil and Milk in Food Group, L.P.G. Gas in Fuel & Power Group both in Urban and Rural Areas.
 - The average prices of the five main commodities in the State during July, 2010 (P) were
 - 1) Rice : ₹ 20.17 (₹ 18.70) in urban areas and ₹ 18.20 (₹ 16.07) in rural areas
 - 2) Wheat : ₹ 13.58 (₹ 10.92) in urban areas and ₹ 11.04 (₹ 9.15) in rural areas
 - 3) Tur Dal : ₹ 71.34 (₹ 78.87) in urban areas and ₹ 69.96 (₹ 78.41) in rural areas
 - 4) Sugar : ₹ 29.87 (₹ 26.07) in urban areas and ₹ 29.49 (₹ 25.81) in rural areas
 - 5) Groundnut Oil : ₹ 78.40 (₹ 69.91) in urban areas and ₹ 79.69 (₹ 71.70) in rural areas
- Note : Figures in brackets are prices for the corresponding period of the previous year.*
- The inflation rate based on CPI, prevailing in the State during July, 2010 (over corresponding month of the previous year) was 13.4 per cent (P) in Urban areas and 11.4 per cent (P) in Rural areas.
 - The inflation rate based on All India Wholesale Price Index (WPI) was 10.6 per cent (P) during June, 2010. This rate was 16.3 per cent (P) for Primary Articles.
 - The All-India CPI for Industrial Workers, CPI (IW) increased by 13.7 per cent during June, 2010 over the corresponding period of the previous year.

2. Economic Indicators

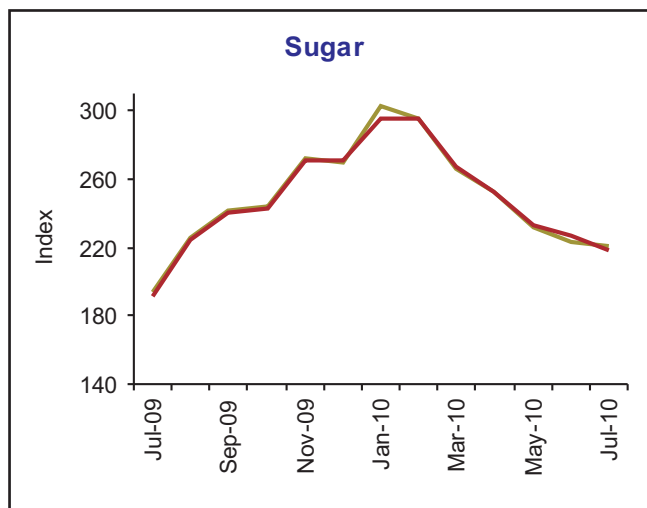
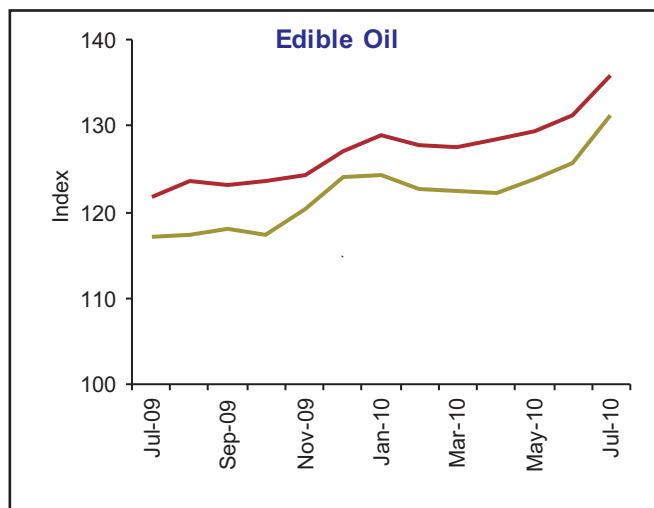
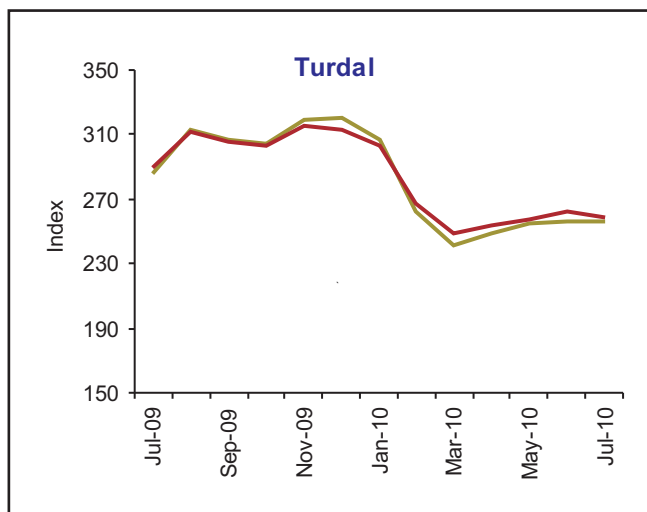
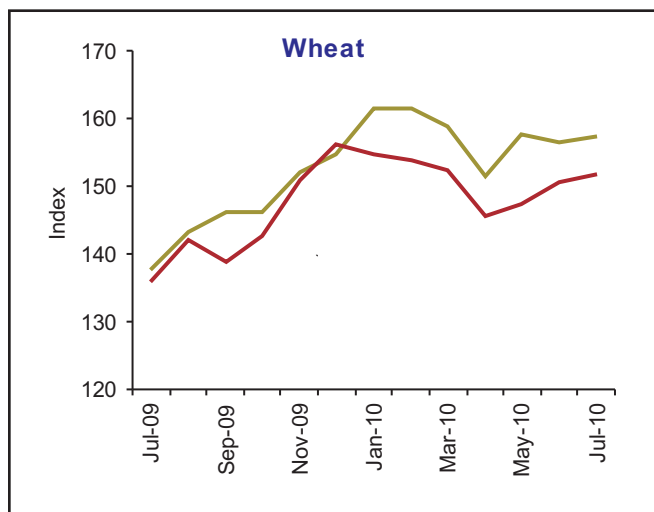
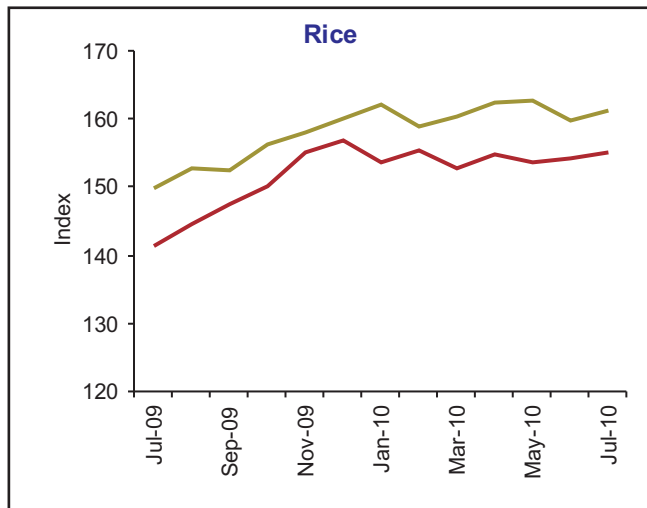
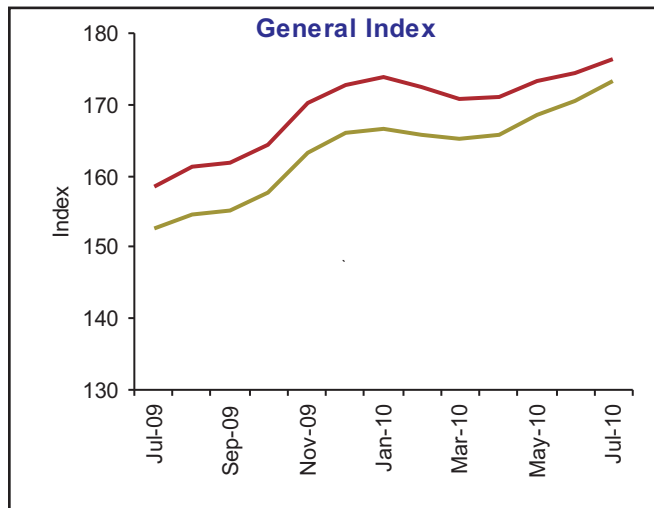
- All India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) during May, 2010 was 312.6, more by 11.5 per cent while the Index of Manufacturing sector was 335.3, more by 12.3 per cent over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- The broad money supply (M₃) in the economy as on July 16, 2010 was more by 22.5 per cent than that was prevailing on the corresponding day of the previous year.
- The revenue receipts of the State Government during 2010-11 upto June, 2010 was ₹ 22,931 crore of which tax revenue was ₹ 19,558 crore.
- The revenue expenditure of the State Government during 2010-11 upto June, 2010 was ₹ 16,942 crore of which plan expenditure was ₹ 698 crore.
- Sensex of Bombay Stock Exchange as on July 30, 2010 was 17,868 and Nifty of National Stock Exchange was 5,368.
