***About this Bulletin***

The Directorate of Economics & Statistics constantly monitors the consumer prices in the State through 142 centers (74 in urban areas & 68 in rural areas) spread throughout the State. A bulletin indicating the prices prevailing in the State and some major economic indicators of the State and also at the National Level is published on a monthly basis. A summary of these findings is placed below.

***Summary***

***1. Prices***

- The Consumer Price Indices compiled separately for urban and rural areas of the State for May, 2010 (Prov.) were 168.5 and 173.1 respectively, as against 165.7 & 171.0 during April, 2010
- The increase in index during May, 2010 (Prov.) was mainly due to increase in the prices of Milk and Vegetables in food group in urban areas and Milk, Vegetables and Jowar in rural areas.
- The average prices of the five main commodities in the State during May, 2010 (P) were
  - 1) Rice : Rs.20.56 (Rs.18.74) in urban areas and Rs.18.08 (Rs.16.86) in rural areas
  - 2) Wheat : Rs.12.91 (Rs.11.34) in urban areas and Rs.10.32 (Rs. 9.92) in rural areas
  - 3) Tur Dal : Rs.70.64 (Rs.56.19) in urban areas and Rs.69.86 (Rs.54.63) in rural areas
  - 4) Sugar : Rs.31.44 (Rs.25.17) in urban areas and Rs.31.51 (Rs.24.65) in rural areas
  - 5) Groundnut Oil : Rs.73.96 (Rs.73.02) in urban areas and Rs.76.08 (Rs.74.50) in rural areas

*Note : Figures in brackets are prices for the corresponding period of the previous year.*

- The inflation rate based on CPI, prevailing in the State during May, 2010 (over corresponding month of the previous year) was 15.3 per cent in Urban areas and 14.3 per cent in Rural areas.
- The inflation rate based on All-India Wholesale Price Index (WPI) was 9.6 per cent during April, 2010. This rate was 13.9 per cent for Primary Articles.
- The All-India CPI for Industrial Workers, CPI (IW) increased by 13.3 percent during April, 2010 over the corresponding period of the previous year.

***2. Economic Indicators***

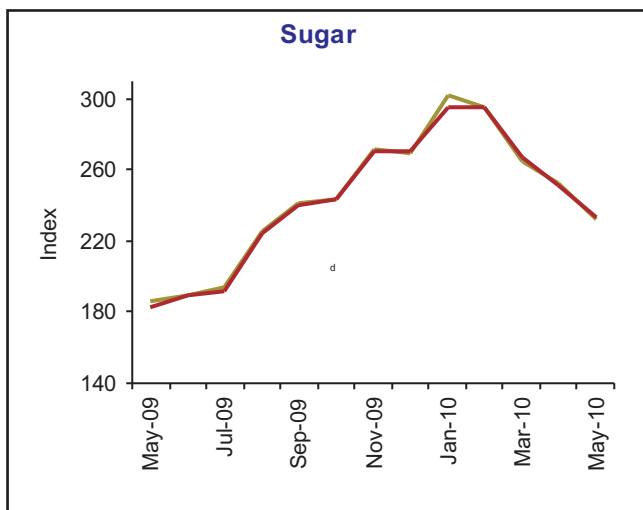
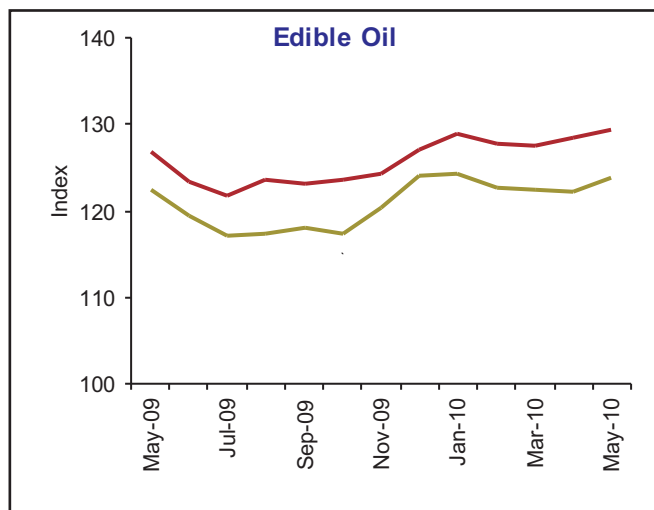
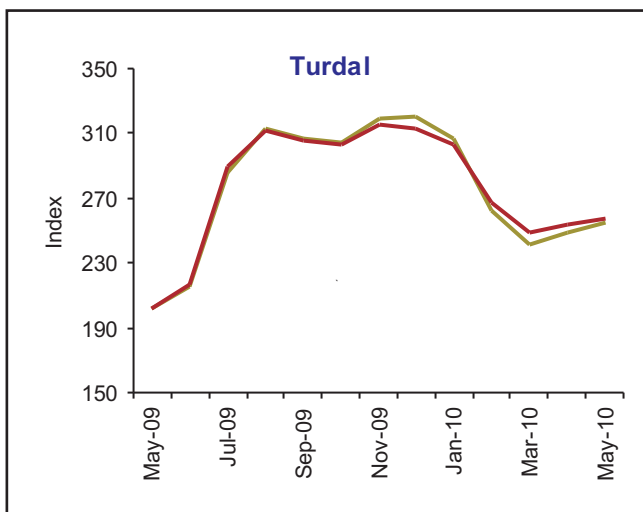
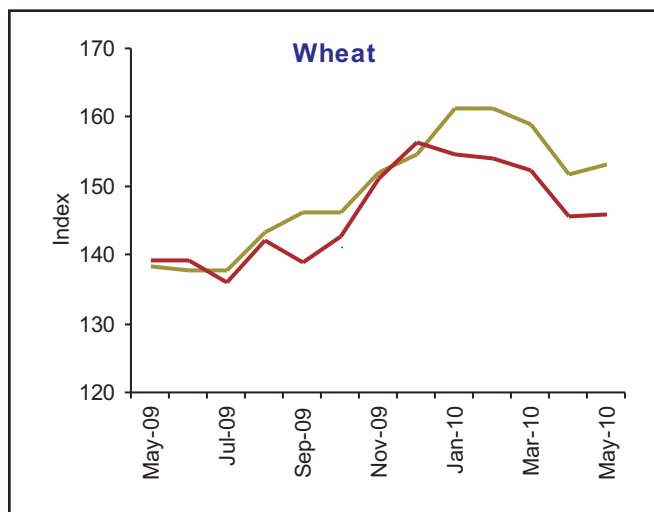
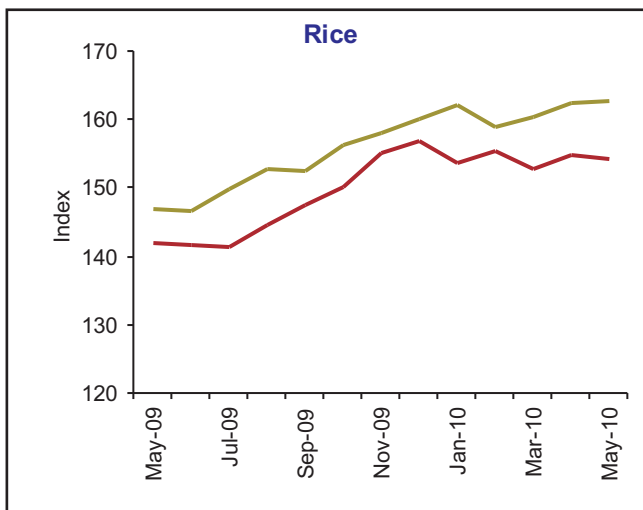
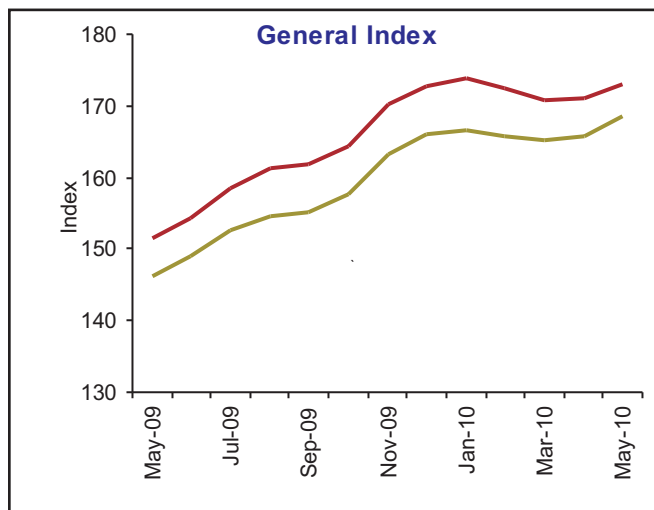
- As per the advance estimates, the State economy is expected to grow by 8.6 per cent during 2009-10. The sectoral growth rates of GSDP are expected to be 1.8 per cent for Agriculture & allied activities, 7.0 per cent for Industry and 10.4 per cent for Service sectors.
- All India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) during March, 2010 was 347.3 more by 13.5 per cent while the Index of Manufacturing sector was 373.6 more by 14.3 per cent over the corresponding period of the previous year.
- The broad money supply (M3) in the economy as on May 07, 2010 was more by 14.7 per cent than that was prevailing on the corresponding day of the previous year.
