

# Monthly Bulletin on Consumer Prices & Economy

## About this Bulletin

The Directorate of Economics & Statistics constantly monitors the consumer prices in the State through 142 centers (74 in urban areas & 68 in rural areas) spread throughout the State. This activity has recently been upgraded and also computerised. It is now proposed to bring out a monthly bulletin indicating not only the prices prevailing in the State but also indicate some major Economic Indicators in the State and at the national level. A brief summary of these findings is placed below.

## Summary

### 1. Prices

- The Consumer Price Index compiled separately for urban and rural areas of the State for September, 2009 (Prov.) were 155.1 and 161.6 respectively, as against 154.7 and 161.3 during August, 2009.
  - The impact of the increase in prices during September, 2009 was mainly due to increase in the prices of food group items (specially prices of Sugar).
  - The average prices of the five main commodities in the State during August, 2009 were,
    - 1) Rice : Rs. 19.50 (Rs.17.13) in urban areas and Rs. 16.73 (Rs.14.83) in rural areas
    - 2) Wheat : Rs. 12.34 (Rs.12.82) in urban areas and Rs. 10.16 (Rs.10.42) in rural areas
    - 3) Tur Dal : Rs. 85.18 (Rs.46.68) in urban areas and Rs. 82.86 (Rs.46.71) in rural areas
    - 4) Sugar : Rs. 32.59 (Rs.19.60) in urban areas and Rs. 32.25 (Rs.19.78) in rural areas
    - 5) Groundnut Oil : Rs. 70.66 (Rs.79.62) in urban areas and Rs. 72.43 (Rs.81.52) in rural areas
- Note : Figures in brackets are prices for the corresponding period of the previous year.*
- The inflation rate on the basis of CPI, prevailing in the State during August, 2009 (over corresponding month of the previous year) was 8.3 per cent in Urban areas and 10.6 per cent in Rural areas.
  - The 52 week inflation rate based on All India Wholesale Price Index (WPI) was 1.5 per cent as on 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2009. This rate was as high as 8.7 per cent for Primary Articles.
  - The All-India CPI for Industrial Workers, CPI (IW) increased by 11.7 per cent during August, 2009 over the corresponding period of the previous year.
  - During the same period, the All-India CPI for Rural Labourers, CPI (RL) and for Agricultural Labourers, CPI (AL) also increased during September, 2009, by 12.9 per cent and 13.2 per cent respectively.

### 2. Economic Indicators

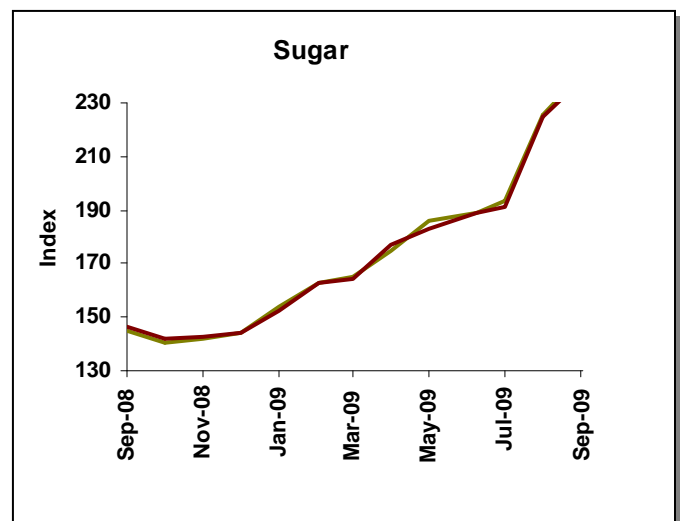
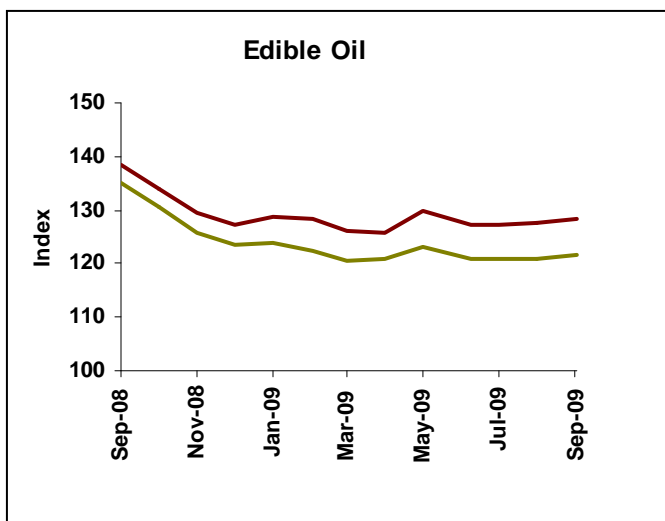
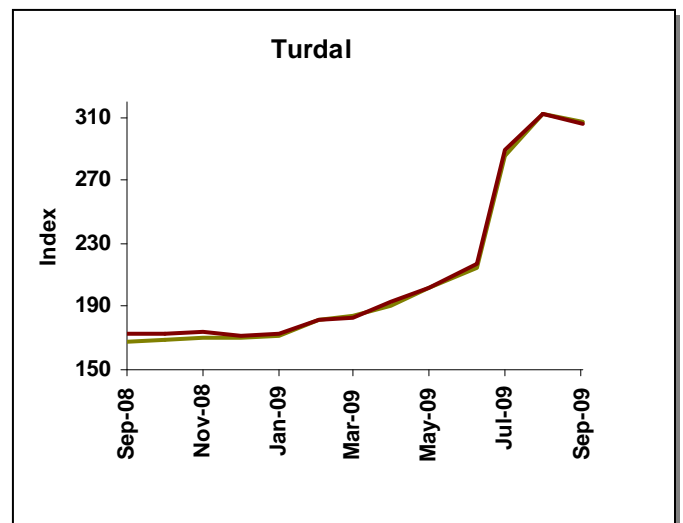
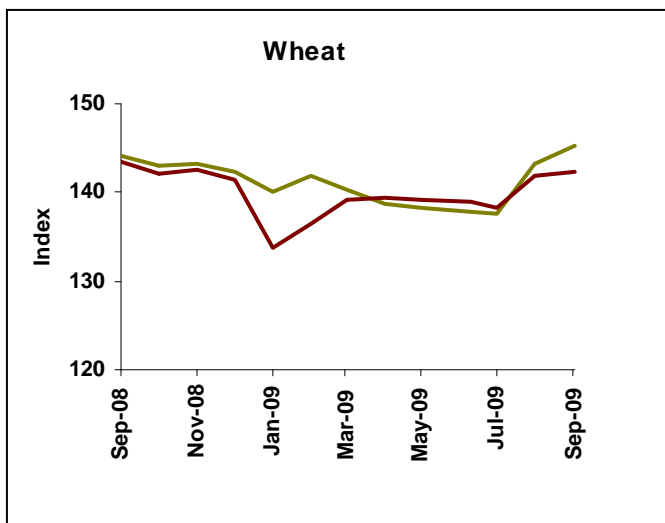
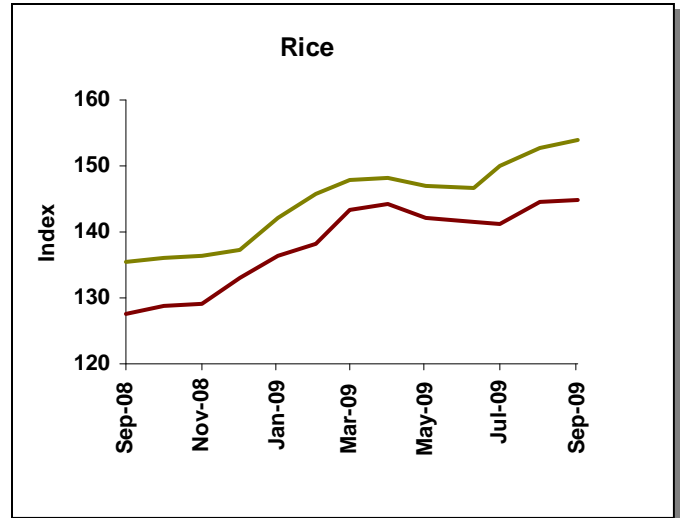
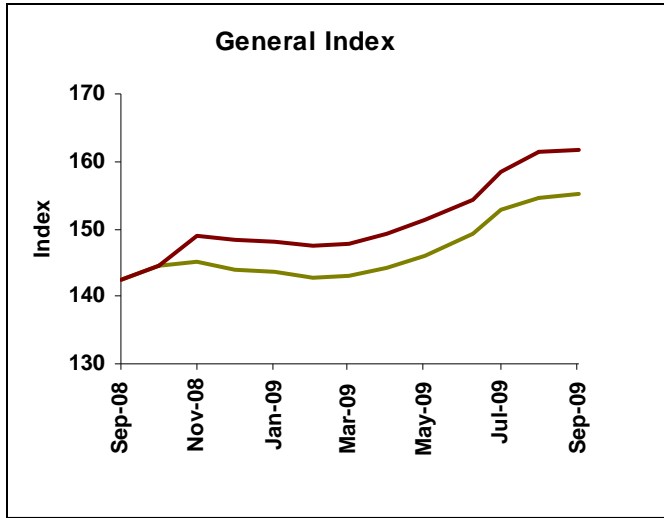
- All India Index of Industrial Production (IIP) during August, 2009 was 292.3, more by 10.4 per cent over the corresponding period of the previous year. During this period Manufacturing sector also increased at about the same rate.
- The revenue receipts of the State Government during first half of the current fiscal were Rs.35,351 crore, whereas the revenue expenditure was Rs.33,851 crore.
- The broad money supply (M3) in the economy as on October 9, 2009 was more by 18.9 per cent than that was prevailing during the corresponding day of the previous year.
