PREFACE

Capital Formation is of paramount importance in a developing economy. It acts as a determinant of economic growth and serves as a yardstick for measurement of capital stock. The productive capacity of the economy depends to a large extent upon the Capital Formation i.e. more the capital accumulation, the higher would be the productive capacity of the economy.

The national level estimates of Capital Formation do not meet the requirements of the individual States due to regional variations. It has, therefore, necessitated the preparation of estimates of Capital Formation at State level. The State level estimates act as an important indicator in measuring the growth of productive potential of State economy. It is an important pre-requisite for formulation of future developmental programmes for the State.

This report presents the estimates of Gross Fixed Capital Formation of Maharashtra at current (base year) (2011-12) prices for the year 2017-18. For preparation of the estimates of Gross Fixed Capital Formation, the standard methodology suggested by the National Statistical Office, New Delhi with suitable modifications, wherever necessary, has been followed. It is hoped that the planners, economists, administrators and research scholars would find the information contained in the report quite useful for having an overview of the State's economy and for planning and formulation of developmental programmes and taking policy decisions.

Executive Summary

The estimates of Capital Formation are of considerable importance in the context of planning and economic development. These estimates throw light on the addition to the capital base of the economy and subsequent change in the modes and capacity of production. The higher the rate of Capital Formation, the higher would be the rate of growth in National/State Product. Capital Formation is defined as that part of country's current output and imports which is not consumed or exported during the accounting period but is set aside as an addition to its stock of capital goods. Total Capital Formation can be broadly classified into Gross Fixed Capital Formation (GFCF) and change in stock of raw materials, semi-finished and finished goods.

The estimates of Capital Formation can be prepared by following any of the three approaches namely:- i) Production or commodity flow approach ii) Savings and flow of funds approach iii) Expenditure approach. At the State level, the estimates of Capital Formation are prepared by following the expenditure approach as the other two approaches are not feasible at present. Similarly, the estimates of change in stock can not be prepared at the State level due to non-availability of data. Therefore, the Directorate Economic & Statistical, Planning Department, Government of Maharashtra prepares the estimates of Gross Fixed Capital Formation (GFCF) only of the State.

The estimates of GFCF at the State level are being worked out i) by industry of use i.e. separately for all the thirteen sectors of economy ii) by type of institutions i.e. for public and private sectors iii) by type of assets i.e. separately for buildings, roads and bridges, other constructions, plant and machinery, transport equipments and other equipments (including furniture and fixtures). These estimates are prepared by adopting the standard methodology as suggested by the National Statistical Office (NSO), New Delhi. At present, the estimates of GFCF in the State are being prepared at current prices in the series with base year 2011-12.

At current prices, the total GFCF of the State has been estimated at 97564 crore during the year 2017-18 as against 87228 crore during the year 2016-17 resulting in an increase of 4.73 percent.

The composition of GFCF reveals that the primary sector comprising agriculture, forestry, fishing and aquaculture sectors has contributed 10.36 percent, secondary sector consisting of mining and quarrying, manufacturing, construction and electricity, gas & water supply sectors has contributed 29.02 percent and tertiary sector which consists of trade, hotels & restaurant, transport, storage, communication, banking, real estate, ownership of dwelling & business services, public administration and other services has contributed 60.60 percent /in total GFCF at current prices, respectively in 2017-18. It shows that tertiary sector has contributed maximum to the State GFCF followed by secondary and primary sectors.

Gross Fixed Capital Formation (Public Sector): An Overview

1. Introduction

Investment measured by Gross Capital Formation (GCF) comprises Gross Fixed Capital Formation (GFCF) and Change in Stock (CIS). **Gross Fixed capital Formation (GFCF)** measures expenditure on non-financial assets from both the public and private sectors. More specifically, it measures the acquisitions less disposals of fixed assets such as land, buildings, software, transport equipment and machinery, cultivated biological resources (including animal resources trees and plants) used in the production process for more than one year, which is otherwise refers to creation of physical assets.

Change in stock primarily measures the inventories i.e. the working capital. But GFCF is an important factor within an economy as it captures the productive capacity of the economy and measures its potential growth. Thus GFCF is the barometer of economic development and growth potential of the economy.

(a) Acquisitions less disposals of new or existing tangible fixed assets are sub-divided by type of asset into :

- Dwellings,
- Other buildings and structures;
- Machinery and equipment;
- Cultivated assets – trees and livestock-that are used repeatedly or continuously to produce products such as fruit, rubber, milk etc.

(b) Acquisitions less disposals of new and existing intangible fixed assets sub-divided by type of asset into:

- Mineral exploration;
- Computer software
- Entertainment, literary or artistic originals;
- Other intangible fixed assets;
- Major improvements to tangible non-produced assets including land;
- Costs associated with the transfers of ownership non-produced assets.

The various components of acquisitions and disposals of fixed assets as referred to in categories (a) and (b) above are listed below:

- (a) Value of fixed assets purchased
- (b) Value of fixed assets acquired through barter,

- (c) Value of fixed assets received as capital transfers in kind;
- (d) Value of fixed assets retained by their producers for their own use including the value of any fixed assets being produced on own account that are not yet completed or fully mature;

Less

- (e) Value of existing fixed assets sold;
- (f) Value of existing fixed assets surrendered in barter;
- (g) Value of existing fixed assets surrendered as capital transfers

2. Approaches

As per SNA-2008, there are three approaches used for estimation of capital formation. Hence, capital formation can be prepared by any one of the following three approaches.

Production or commodity flow approach:

In this approach the estimates for entire country/states/regional economy is prepared on the basis of commodities flowing into various types of assets of the capital formation namely construction, machinery, software etc.

Saving and flow of funds approach:

In this approach the estimates of saving are prepared and then the net capital inflow from outside the region/state/country is added to get the total estimates of capital formation.

Expenditure approach:

In this approach the expenditure incurred on acquiring various types of fixed assets namely construction, machinery & equipment, cultivated biological resources and software is estimated and Gross Fixed Capital Formation (GFCF) is arrived at. To this change in stocks is added to obtain capital formation.

At national level, all the three approaches are currently adopted by the NSO. But at the State level, estimates of GFCF is compiled by using expenditure approach only since movement of various assets and the estimation of change in stock is not conceptually viable or feasible at the state level due to open boundaries of the states.

3. Coverage

For the purpose of estimation of GFCF, the economy of the State has been classified into 11 industry groups of use Viz.,

1. Agriculture (including Animal Husbandry, Forestry and Fishing)
2. Mining and Quarrying
3. Manufacturing
4. Electricity, Gas, Water and other Utility Services
5. Construction
6. Trade, Hotels & Restaurants
7. Transport, Storage, Communications and services related to Broadcasting
8. Financing Services
9. Real Estate, Ownership of Dwelling and Professional Services
10. Public Administration and Defence
11. Other Services.

The Public sector GFCF of each industry group is further classified into the following four Institutional sectors:

1. General Government (GG)
2. Departmental Commercial Undertakings (DCUs)
3. Non-Departmental Commercial Undertakings (NDCUs)
4. Autonomous Bodies (AB)

The General Government contains central and state govt. administration including local bodies, central govt. DCU and central govt. autonomous bodies. The DCU covers only state govt. departmental commercial undertakings. NDCU covers both state and central undertakings. Autonomous bodies include only state autonomous institutions.

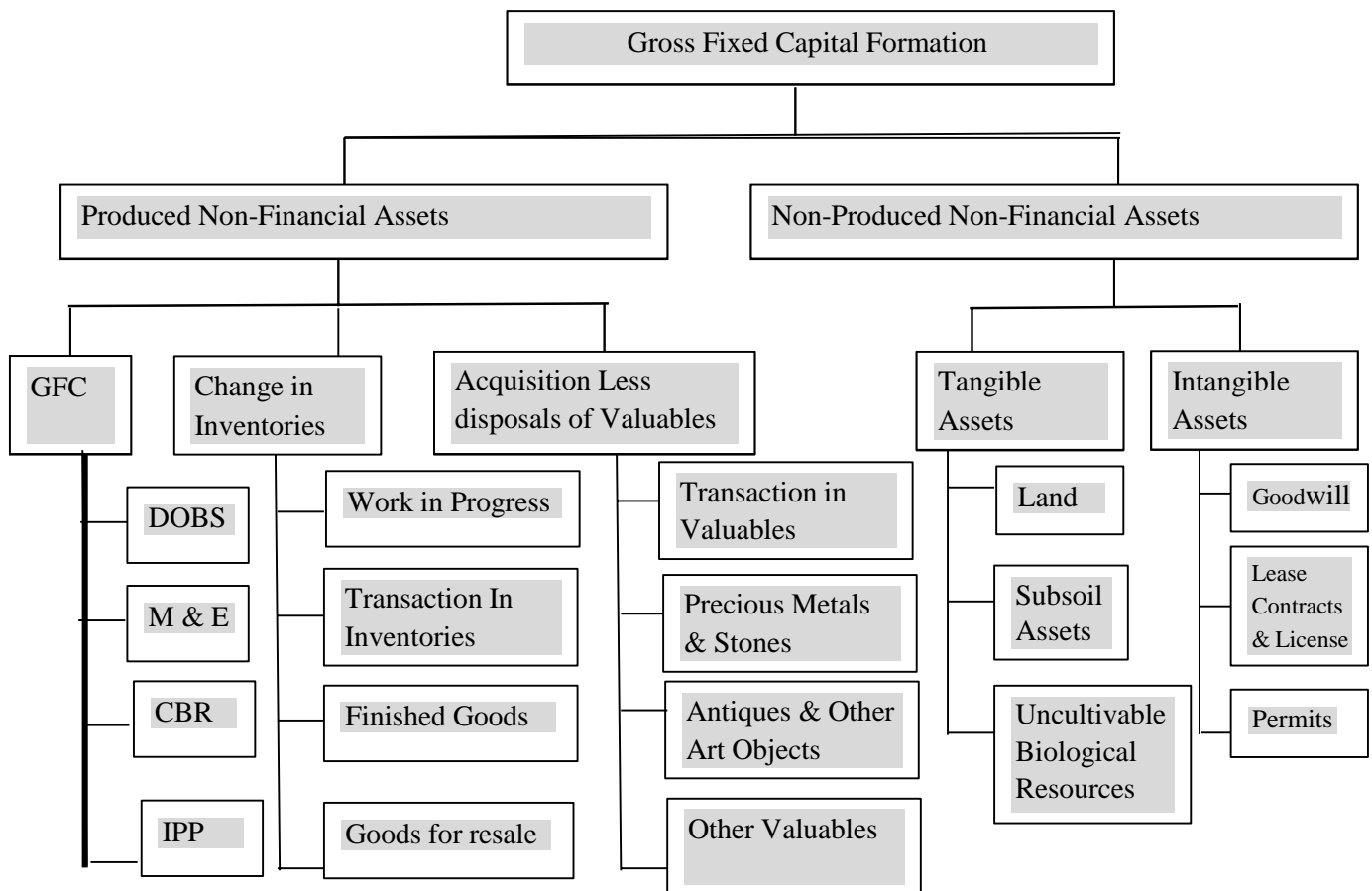
The GFCF of state institutions has been analyzed using expenditure approach. The GFCF of all central institutions has been analyzed at NSO level and share of the state is allocated

COVERAGE, METHODOLOGY & DATA SOURCE

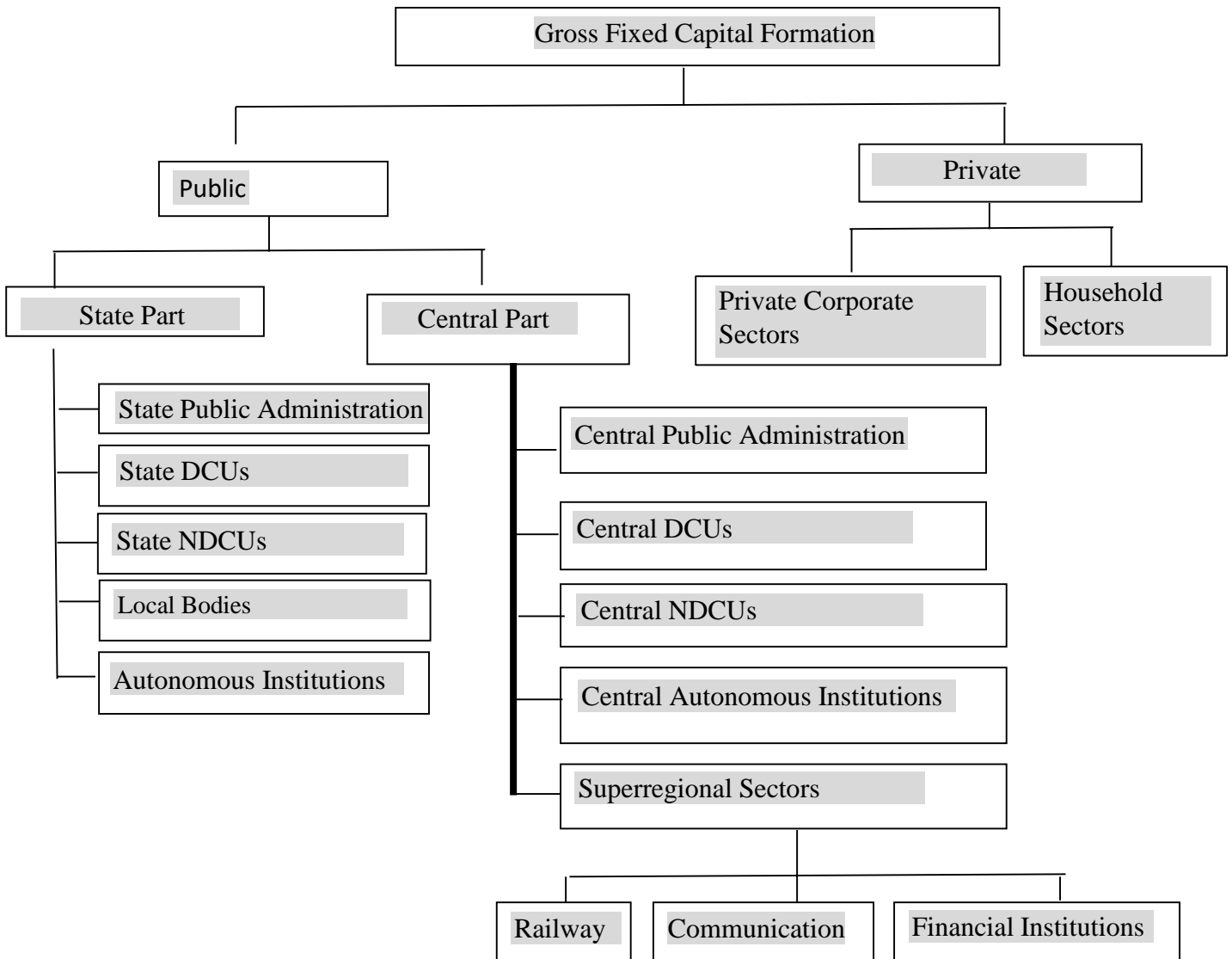
As mentioned above the Gross Fixed Capital Formation (GFCF) is the part of the Gross Capital Formation exercise done at the national level. Due to data constraint & lack to manpower the public share of gross capital formation of the state is estimated through this publication. Though it is much better to have a clear idea of what the gross capital formation is all about through the following graph.

Now extending the above understanding regarding gross fixed capital formation, following graph will help to understand the coverage.

It is clear from above graphs that private & household sector need to be covered in order to have the gross fixed capital formation of the state. The current publication though covers only the public sector; still it gives a fair idea of the strength of the economy developed over years through public sector contribution. Gross capital formation is still a distant dream & much moreworkings need to done before arriving its final estimation. Here on the methodology adopted in the estimation of public sector GFCF institution-wise & asset-wise along with data source is discussed.

Administrative Departments: -

Administrative departments comprise government departments /organizations of the Centre, the States and the local authorities whose functions is to produce and provide for the community public goods and services which cannot be conveniently or economically provided by the market.

In case of Central public administrative department, the consolidated figure of GFCF is provided by NSO, which is further classified asset wise & industry wise on the basis of ratios provided in the NAS 2017. However for State public administrative department, the asset wise classification is taken from the budget analysis done by DES & industry-wise classification is done on the basis of nature of expenditure recorded in the budget document of the state.

Departmental Enterprise or Departmental Commercial Undertaking:-

Departmental Enterprises (DE) also referred to as Departmental Commercial Undertakings (DCUs) are unincorporated enterprises owned, controlled and run directly by public authorities. These enterprises normally do not hold or manage financial assets and liabilities apart from their working balances and business accounts payables and receivables. These are included in public financial and non-financial institutions on the basis of their activity. The distinction between administrative department & DE is that administrative Departments are Government Agencies of the Central, State and Local Bodies organising for the community but not normally to sell those common services which otherwise cannot be provided conveniently or economically. It is expected to act as an administrative agency for the social and economic policy of the country while DCU operate on commercial basis. The Criteria to distinguish Enterprises and administrative activity is the engagement in market production.

In case of Central DE, the consolidated figure of GFCF is provided by NSO, which is further classified asset wise & industry wise on the basis of ratios provided in the NAS 2017. However for State DE, the asset wise classification is taken from the budget analysis done by DES & industry-wise classification is done on the basis of nature of expenditure recorded in the budget document of the state.

Non-Departmental Enterprise or Non-Departmental Commercial Units:-

Non Departments Enterprise (NDE) or Non Departmental Commercial Units (NDCUs) are an economic entity that is capable in its own right of owning goods and assets, incurring liabilities and engage in economic activities and in transactions with other entities. NDEs comprise government companies in which not less than 51 percent of the paid up capital is held by the central government or state government or partly by one or more state governments, subsidiaries of government companies, statutory corporations set up under special enactments of parliament or state legislatures.

In case of Central NDE, the GFCF is provided by NSO, which is further classified asset wise & industry wise on the basis of ratios provided in the NAS 2017. However for State NDE, the asset wise classification is taken from the budget analysis done by DES & industry-wise classification is done on the basis of nature of expenditure recorded in the budget document of the state.

Autonomous Institution: -

As per SNA 2008 the Autonomous Institution are defined as - In addition to government departments and ministries, there may be agencies of central government with separate legal identity and substantial autonomy; they may have discretion over the volume and composition of their expenditures and may have a direct source of revenue such as earmarked ("hypothecated") taxes. Such agencies are often established to carry out specific functions such as road construction or the non-market production of health and education services. These should be treated as separate institutional units if they maintain full sets of accounts but are part of central government sub sector if the services they produce are non-market and if they are controlled by central government.

Autonomous Institutions are set up by the Ministries/Departments concerned with the subject matter and are funded through grants-in-aid, either fully or partially, depending on the extent which such institutes generate internal resources of their own. Some of the autonomous bodies have been set up as statutory institutions, as a sequel to the provisions contained in various acts. In most others have been set up as societies under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. Autonomous Bodies are Non-profit institutions controlled and mainly financed by government are properly constituted legal entities which exist separately from government but which are financed mainly by government and over which government exercises control. Grants provided to these institutes are regulated by the Ministry/ department under which they are working through their instructions as well as the instructions relating to powers for creation of posts etc. Autonomous bodies are envisaged to promote the financial and administrative autonomy within the public sector. However the extent of autonomy is limited to the extent of the Act of Parliament or legislature under which they are created and they remain under the overall purview of the government through its various ministries and departments.

Although they may earn profits, Autonomous Bodies are not organized for profit and cannot distribute any profits earned to their owners. They therefore have different objective functions from the other firms. These institutions are often driven by social or ideological impulses, not primarily pecuniary ones. These institutions are typically exempt from corporate income taxes, and may also be exempt from other taxes, such as sales taxes and property taxes. Their major involvement is in the production of public goods while in addition they may produce private goods. Special legal provisions pertaining to governance, reporting requirements, political participation and related matters.

In case of Central AIs, the GFCF is provided by NSO, which is further classified asset wise & industry wise on the basis of ratios provided in the NAS 2017. However for State AIs, the asset wise & industry wise classification is done on the basis of separate analysis done of the balance sheets, income & expenditure & receipts & payment accounts provided by the state Autonomous Institutions & per the nature of AIs. However multiplier is used where the institution does not furnish the balance sheets & other accounts.

Supra Regional Sector : -

Supra-regional sector comprises of Railways, Communication & Financial Institution whose functioning are not possible to be defined within the state or district boundaries. The consolidated estimates of GFCF of Supra-regional sectors i.e. Railways, Communication & Financial Services for the state is provided by NSO, which is further classified asset wise & industry wise on the basis of ratios provided in the NAS 2017.

Local Bodies: -

Data regarding local bodies is readily available, as DES Maharashtra is collecting their income-expenditure statements annually and produce all sets of accounts of local bodies on annual basis. The capital formation accounts are used to estimate the contribution of local bodies in the public sector gross fixed capital formation of the state.

In nutshell the methodology & sources used for estimating the contribution of public units in the public sector GFCF of the state is as follows:

APPENDIX

MEANING AND CLASSIFICATION OF ASSETS

1. Meaning and Definition

The System of National Accounts (SNA) defines an economic asset as “an entity functioning as a store of value:

- over which ownership rights are enforced by institutional units individually or collectively; and
- from which economic benefits may be derived by its owner by holding it or using it over a period of time.

The first restriction in this definition serves to limit the concept of assets to items that are effectively claimed by an economic agent excluding for instance, international waters or wild birds and the second restriction says that only items with an economic value are taken into account.

Many assets come into existence as outputs from production processes. They are called non-financial produced assets. However, there are further conditions. People often think that produced assets should be tangible, i.e., they are “goods.” However, this is not the case: the SNA classifies cost on mineral exploration, computer software and the value of produced entertainment, literary or artistic originals also covered under the group of produced assets when they are actually traded on markets.

The second classes of asset which may be distinguished consist of non-financial non-produced assets. This group includes, among other things, land and water resources, mineral deposits, virgin forests and non-cultivated fisheries provided that ownership rights over them are enforced. Certain intangibles are also included such as patent rights (including those brought about by research and development activities), transferable contracts and purchased good will.

The third and last group consists of financial assets. These assets arise out of contractual relationships between two institutional units under which one unit is entitled to receive a payment or series of payments from the other unit. Also included are monetary gold, Special Drawing Rights (SDRs), shares and other securities in corporations and financial derivatives.

Except monetary gold and SDRs, every financial asset has a counterpart liability representing the obligation of the debtor to pay the amounts specified in the contract. The balance sheet records both non-financial assets and financial assets and the counterpart liabilities. The difference between the aggregate value of the assets of all types owned by an institutional unit and the value of its liabilities is called its net worth. Net worth is an indicator of wealth.

2. Classification of Assets

Non-financial assets:

A. Produced assets:

a. Fixed

- i) Tangible: dwellings, other buildings & structures, machinery & equipment, cultivated assets
- ii) Intangible: mineral exploration, computer software, entertainment etc.

b. Inventories

c. Valuables

B. Non-produced assets:

- a) Tangible: land, subsoil assets, non-cultivated biological resources, water etc.
- b) Intangible: patents, leases, goodwill

3. Financial assets:

- a. Monetary gold and SDRs
- b. Currency and deposits
- c. Securities other than shares
- d. Shares and other equity
- e. Loans
- f. Insurance technical reserves
- g. Accounts receivable/payable.

The broad classification of assets distinguishes first between non-financial versus financial assets. The first group is further broken down between produced assets and non-produced assets.

Non-financial produced assets

It consists of fixed assets, inventories and valuables. *Fixed assets* are those which are used repeatedly or continuously in production processes for more than one year. Not included are small, inexpensive tools, such as hammers and screwdrivers. Included are for instance, dwellings occupied by their owner, livestock or trees used repeatedly to produce other goods and services, mineral exploration, computer software and artistic originals if ownership rights have been established over them. *Inventories* comprise materials and supplies, work-in-progress, finished goods held by the enterprise that produced them, and goods for resale. *Valuables* are goods primarily as stores of value in the expectation that they hold their value in real terms in the long run, e.g. precious stones and metals, works of art, and antiques. But monetary gold held by the authorities responsible for the management of foreign reserves is not included. It is rather classified as financial asset.

Non-financial non-produced assets

These are broken down into tangible assets and intangible assets. Tangible assets are land, natural water resources and other biological reserves which are not under the direct control, responsibility and management of an institutional unit but are economically exploitable (such as virgin forests which are used for collecting firewood). The intangibles consist of patented inventions, transferable leases and purchased goodwill. The value of goodwill includes anything of long-term benefit to an enterprise that has not been separately identified as an asset.

Financial Assets

These assets are broken down between monetary gold and SDRs, currency and deposits, securities other than shares, shares and other accounts receivable or payable. Monetary gold is gold that is held as a financial asset as a component of foreign reserves. SDRs are international reserve assets created by the IMF to supplement other reserve assets of official holders. Currency and deposits are financial assets used to make payments, such as notes and coins, and checking accounts. Securities other than shares are assets that are traded in financial markets and usually give the holders the unconditional right to receive a stated fixed sum on a specified date. Examples are bill, bonds, and bankers' acceptances. Shares and other equity are instruments that acknowledge claims on the residual value of incorporated enterprises. Included is the net equity of the owner in quasi-corporations. Other accounts receivable or payable are trade credit, receivable taxes, receivable wages, etc.

GFCF Estimate by Types of Assets:

Estimation of GFCF by Types of Assets implies gross addition less disposal of various types of fixed assets (whether tangible or intangible), except land during the accounting period. As per System of National Accounts 2008, GFCF estimates in the new series (i.e. with base year 2011-12) are compiled for the following broad categories of assets:

I. Dwellings and Other Building Structures (DOBS)

This category of asset includes building outlay residential (BOR), building outlay non-residential (BONR), other construction outlay (CO), land improvement (LI) and roads & bridges outlay (RO) as explained below:

Dwelling (BOR): Dwellings are buildings, or designated parts of buildings, that are used entirely or primarily as residences, including any associated structures, such as garages, and all permanent fixtures customarily installed in residences.

Examples of Dwelling: Residential buildings for communities, Retirement Homes (Old Age Home), Hostels, Orphanage, Houseboats, Mobile Homes and Caravans (used as principal residences of households not for commercial purpose)

Buildings other than Dwelling (BONR): It includes whole buildings or parts of buildings not designated as dwellings. Fixtures, facilities and equipment that are integral parts of the structures are included. For new buildings, costs of site clearance and preparation are included.

Examples of Buildings other than Dwelling (BONR): Warehouse, Commercial Buildings, Hotel, Restaurants, School, Hospitals, Prison, Industrial Building, Library, Rest House etc.

Other Structure (CO): Other structures include all the structures other than buildings, e.g. Waterways, Harbours, Dams, canals, Flood control works, water channel drainage system, playground, swimming pools, ponds, gas pipe lines, cable lines etc.

Land Improvements (LI): Land improvements are the result of actions that lead to major improvements in the quantity, quality or productivity of land, or prevent its deterioration. It includes expenditure on following activities like land clearance, land contouring, creation of wells, watering holes etc.

Roads and Bridges (RO): It includes various expenditures incurred on construction of Roads and Bridges. Examples: Highway, streets, roads, Railway and airfield runway, bridges, elevated highway, tunnel, subways, foot over bridge, culverts etc.

II. Machinery & Equipments (M&E)

This category of asset includes information, computer & telecommunication equipments (ICT), other machinery & equipment outlay (MO) and transport equipment outlay (TRO) as follows:

ICT Equipments (ICT): Information, computer and telecommunications (ICT) equipment consists of devices using electronic controls and also the electronic components forming part of these devices. In practice ICT equipment pertains mostly to computer hardware and telecommunication equipment. Example: expenditure on mobile phones, fax machines, radiocommunication, internet, wireless, electronic printers etc.

Other Machinery & Equipment (MO): Other machinery and equipment consists of machinery and equipment not elsewhere classified. It includes for e.g. Power generating machinery, furniture and fixtures, stone crusher, boilers, office equipment, medical appliances, optical instruments, nuclear reactors, electrical machinery and equipment etc. Tools that are inexpensive and purchased at relatively steady rate such as Hand tools are excluded.

Transport Equipment (TRO): Transport equipment consists of equipment for moving people and objects. It includes for e.g. motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers; ships; railway and tramway locomotives and rolling stock; aircraft and spacecraft; and motorcycles, bicycles, etc.

Weapons systems

Weapons systems include vehicles and other equipment such as warships, submarines, military aircraft, tanks, missile carriers and launchers, etc. Most single-use weapons they deliver, such as ammunition, missiles, rockets, bombs, etc., are treated as military inventories. However, some single-use items, such as certain types of ballistic missile with a highly destructive capability, may provide an ongoing service of deterrence against aggressors and therefore meet the general criteria for classification as fixed assets.

III. Cultivated Biological Resources (CBR)

This category of asset includes animal stock outlay (ASO) and cultivated asset outlay (CAO) as explained below:

Animal resources yielding repeat products (ASO):

It covers animals whose natural growth and regeneration are under the direct control and management of institutional units. They include breeding stocks, dairy cattle, sheep or other animals used for wool production and animals used for transportation.

Tree, crop and plant resources yielding repeat products (CAO):

They include trees (including vines and shrubs) cultivated for fruits and nuts, for sap and resin and for bark and leaf products. Trees grown for timber that yield a finished product once only when they are ultimately felled are not fixed assets, just as cereals or vegetables that produce only a single crop when they are harvested cannot be fixed assets.

IV. Intellectual Property Products (IPP):

Examples of intellectual property products are the results of research and development, mineral exploration and evaluation, computer software and databases, and entertainment, literary or artistic originals. They are characterized by the fact that most of their value is attributable to intellectual endeavor. They can be described in general terms in the following way. Intellectual property products are the result of research, development, investigation or innovation leading to knowledge that the developers can market or use to their own benefit in production because use of the knowledge is restricted by means of legal or other protection. The knowledge remains an asset as long as its use can create some form of monopoly profits for its owner. When it is no longer protected or becomes outdated by later developments, it ceases to be an asset. The original is used to make copies that are in turn supplied to other units. The copies may be sold outright or made available under a license.

Research and development (R&D)

Intellectual property products include the results of research and development (R&D). Research and [experimental] development consists of the value of expenditures on creative work undertaken on a systematic basis in order to increase the stock of knowledge, including knowledge of man, culture and society, and use of this stock of knowledge to devise new applications. This does not extend to including human capital as assets within the SNA. The value of research and development (R&D) should be determined in terms of the economic benefits it is expected to provide in the future. In principle, R&D that does not provide an economic benefit to its owner does not constitute a fixed asset and should be treated as intermediate consumption. Unless the market value of the R&D is observed directly, it may, by convention, be valued at the sum of costs, including the cost of unsuccessful R&D.

Mineral exploration and evaluation

Mineral exploration and evaluation consists of the value of expenditures on exploration for petroleum and natural gas and for non-petroleum deposits and subsequent evaluation of the discoveries made. These expenditures include prelicence costs, license and acquisition costs, appraisal costs and the costs of actual test drilling and boring, as well as the costs of aerial and other surveys, transportation costs, etc., incurred to make it possible to carry out the tests. Mineral exploration is undertaken in order to discover new deposits of minerals or fuels that may be exploited commercially. Such exploration may be undertaken on own account by enterprises engaged in mining or the extraction of fuels. Alternatively, specialized enterprises may carry out exploration either for their own purposes or for fees. The information obtained from exploration influences the production activities of those who obtain it over a number of years. The expenditures incurred on exploration within a given accounting period, whether undertaken on own account or not, are therefore treated as expenditures on the acquisition of an intellectual property product and included in the enterprise's gross fixed capital formation.

Computer software and databases

Computer software and databases are grouped together because a computerized database cannot be developed independently of a database management system (DBMS), which is itself computer software.

Computer software

Computer software consists of computer programs, program descriptions and supporting materials for both systems and applications software. Gross fixed capital formation in computer software includes both the initial development and subsequent extensions of software as well as acquisition of copies that are classified as assets.

Databases

Databases consist of files of data organized in such a way as to permit resource-effective access and use of the data. Databases may be developed exclusively for own use or for sale as an entity or for sale by means of a licence to access the information contained. The creation of a database will generally have to be estimated by a sum-of-costs approach. Databases for sale should be valued at their market price, which includes the value of the information content. If the value of a software component is available separately, it should be recorded as the sale of software.

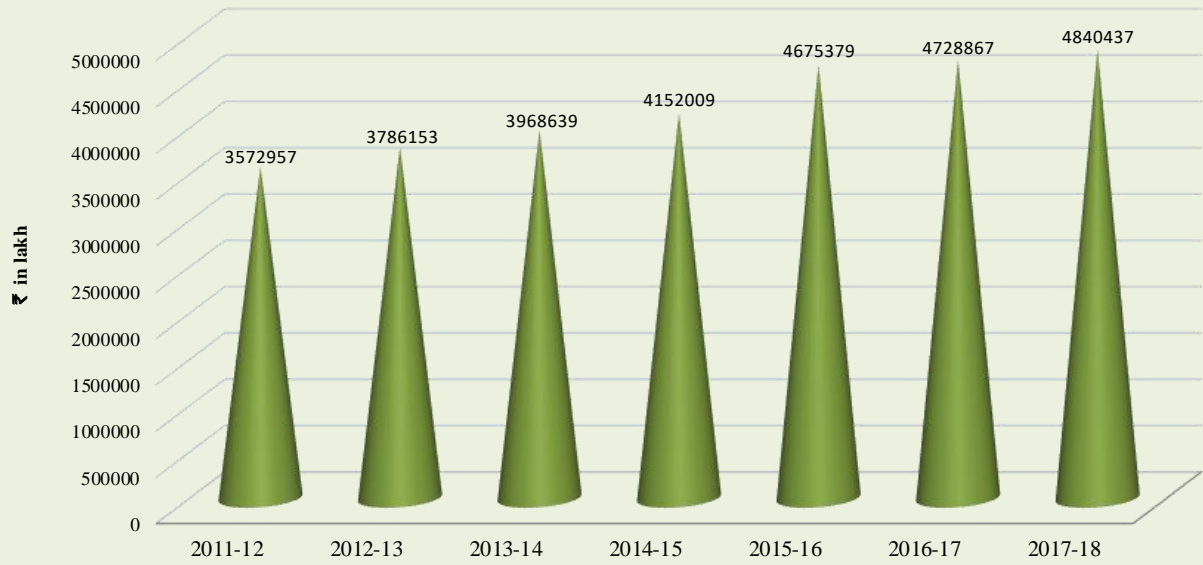
Entertainment, literary and artistic originals

Entertainment, literary and artistic originals consist of the original films, sound recordings, manuscripts, tapes, models, etc., on which drama performances, radio and television programming, musical performances, sporting events, literary and artistic output, etc., are recorded or embodied. Such works are frequently developed on own account. Subsequently they may be sold outright or by means of license. The standard conditions on when the originals and copies are recognized as fixed assets apply.

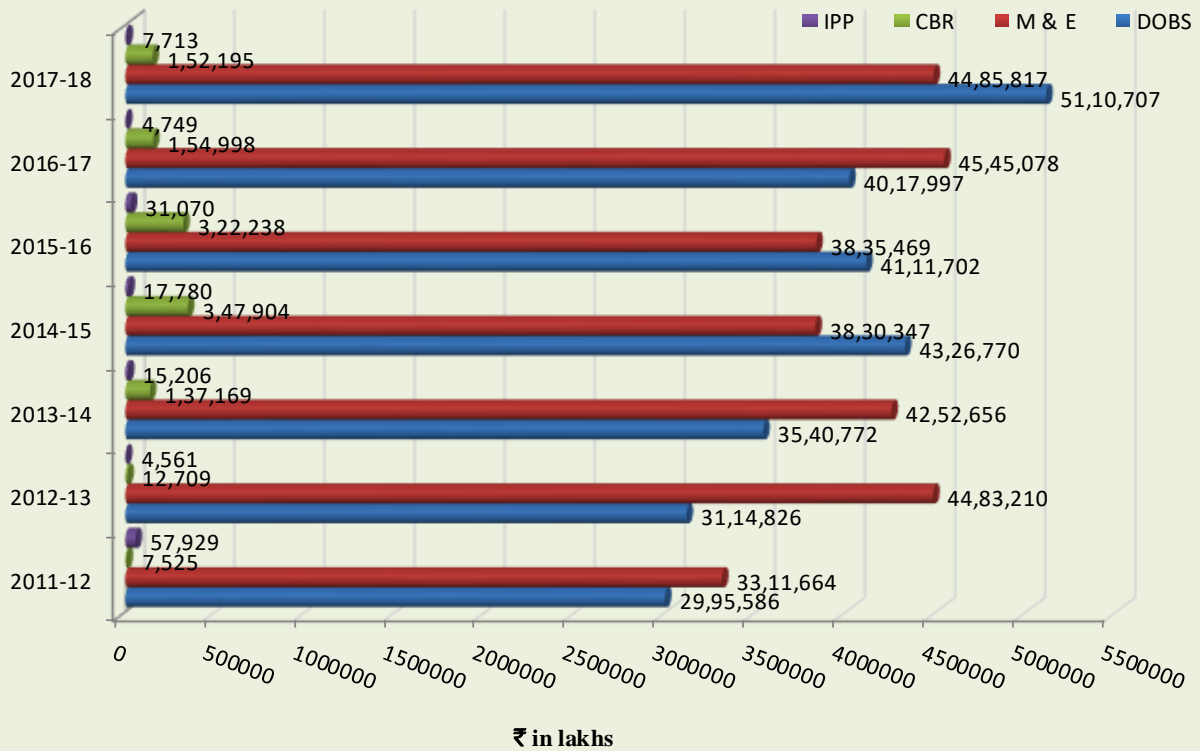
Other intellectual property products

Other intellectual property products include any such products that constitute fixed assets but are not captured in one of the specific items above.

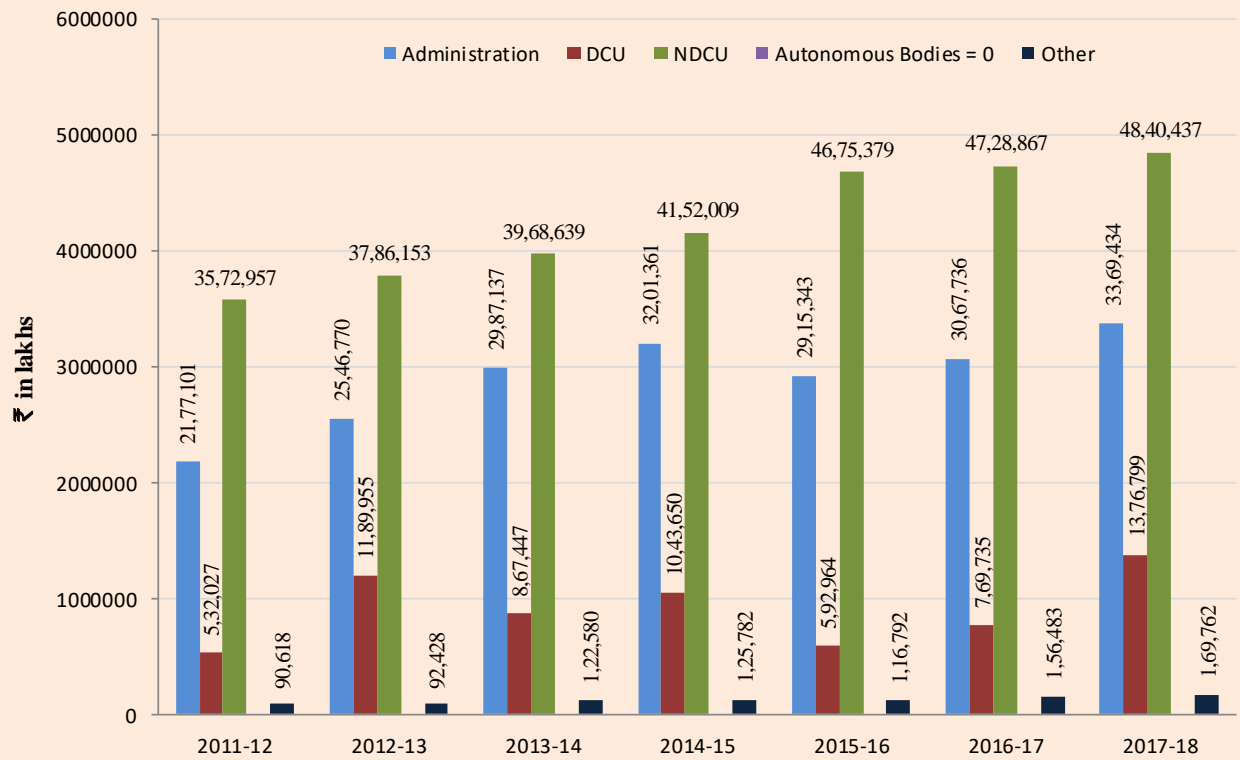
Graph-1: Gross Fixed Capital Formation by SGU & CGU of maharashtra (Public Sector)



Graph-2: Gross Fixed Capital Formation of maharashtra by type of Assets (Public Sector)



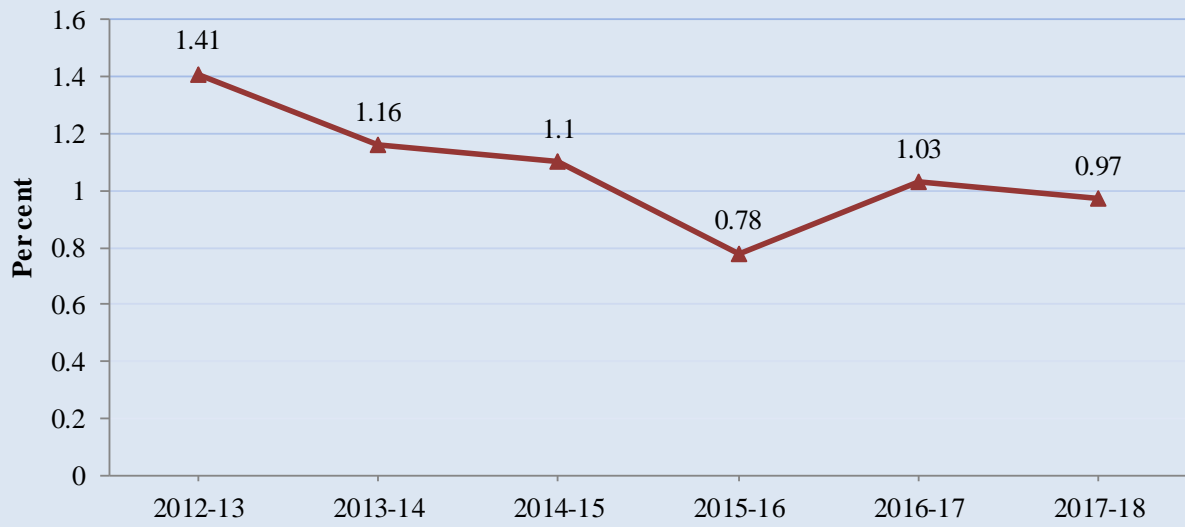
Graph-3: Gross Fixed Capital Formation of maharashtra by type of Institution (Public Sector)



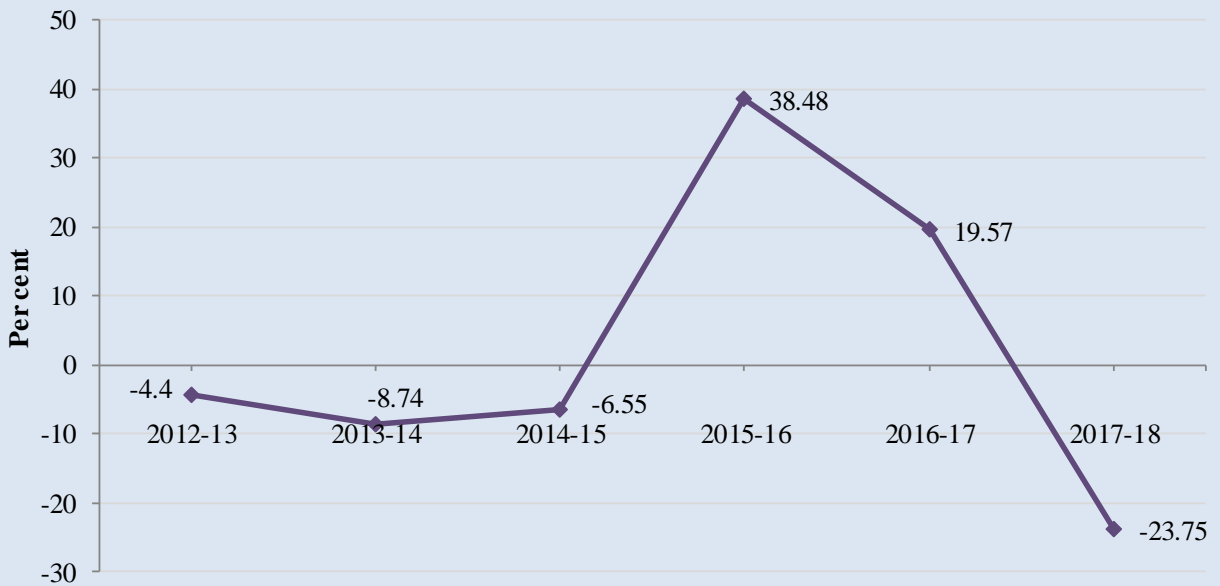
Graph-4: Share of Gross Fixed Capital Formation of Public Sector by type of Industry



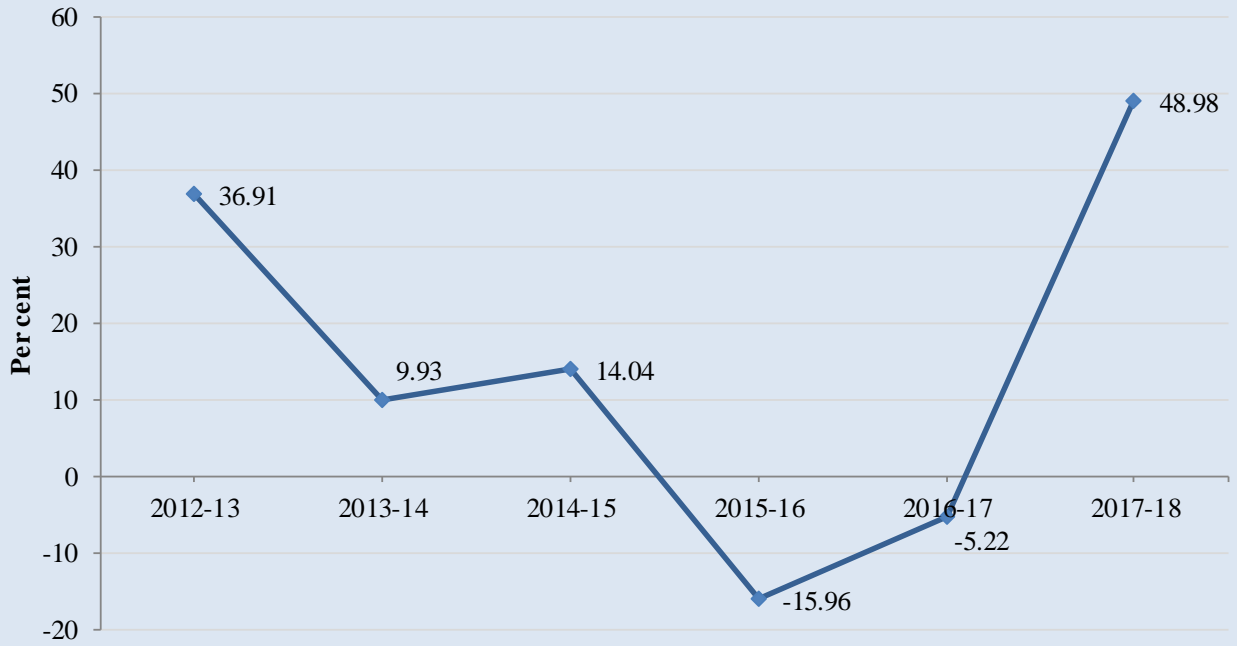
**Graph-5: Growth of GFCF by
Agriculture Sector**



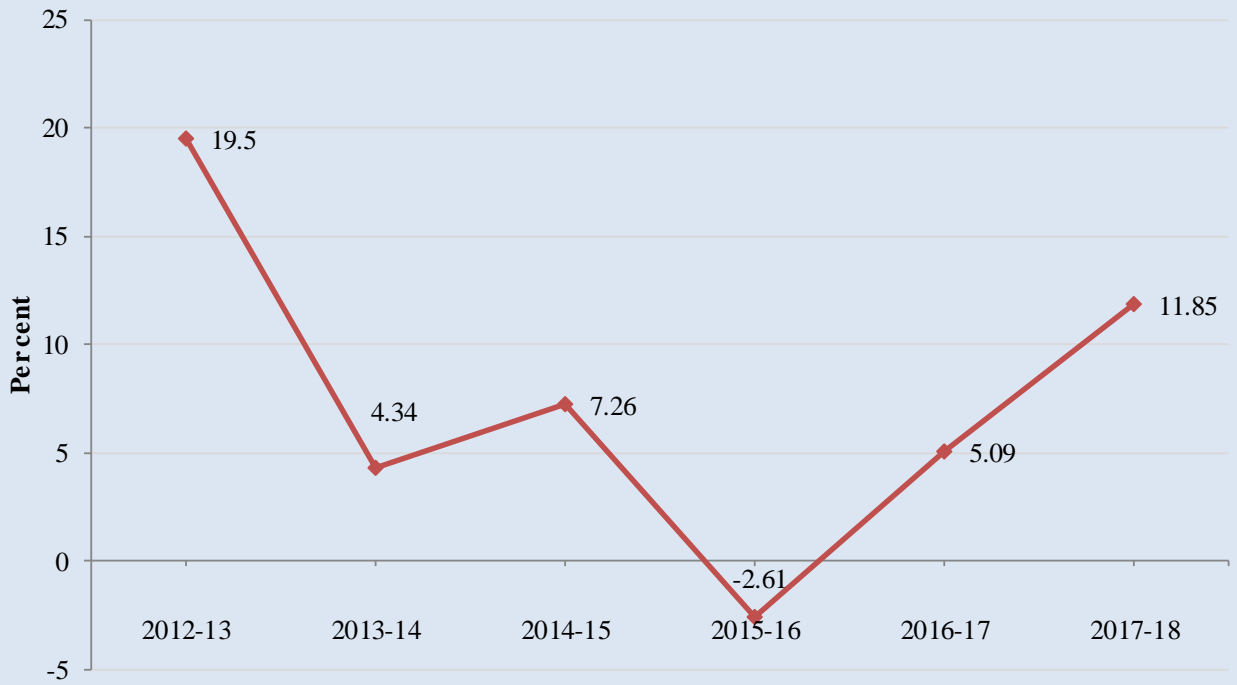
**Graph-6: Growth of GFCF by
Industry Sector**



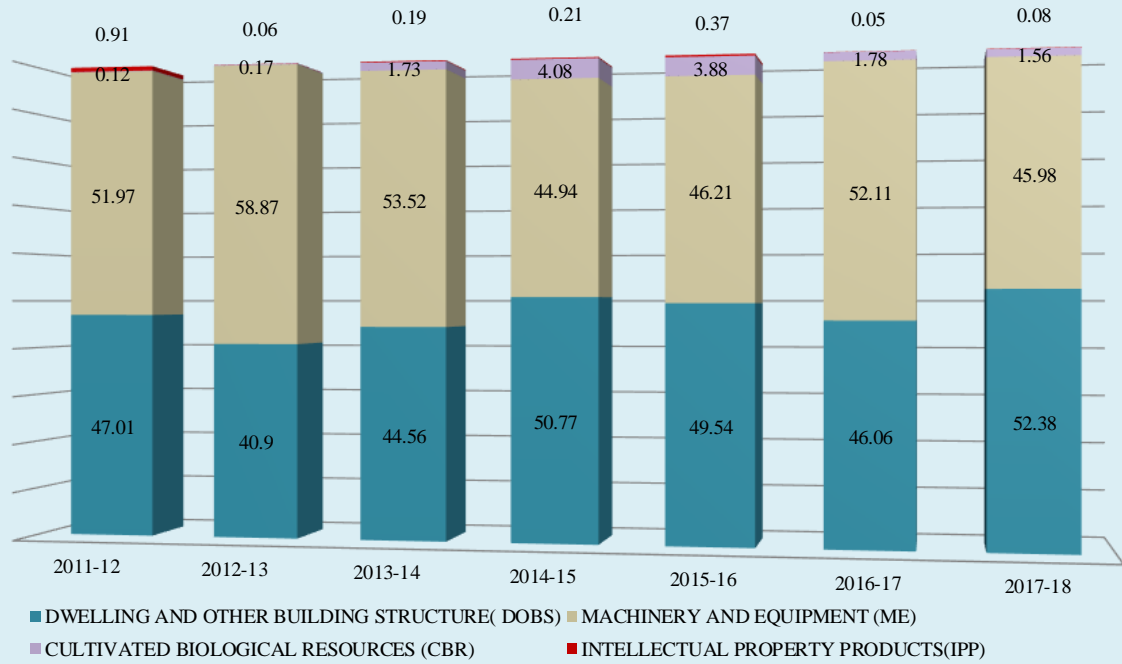
Graph-7: Growth of GFCF by Services Sector



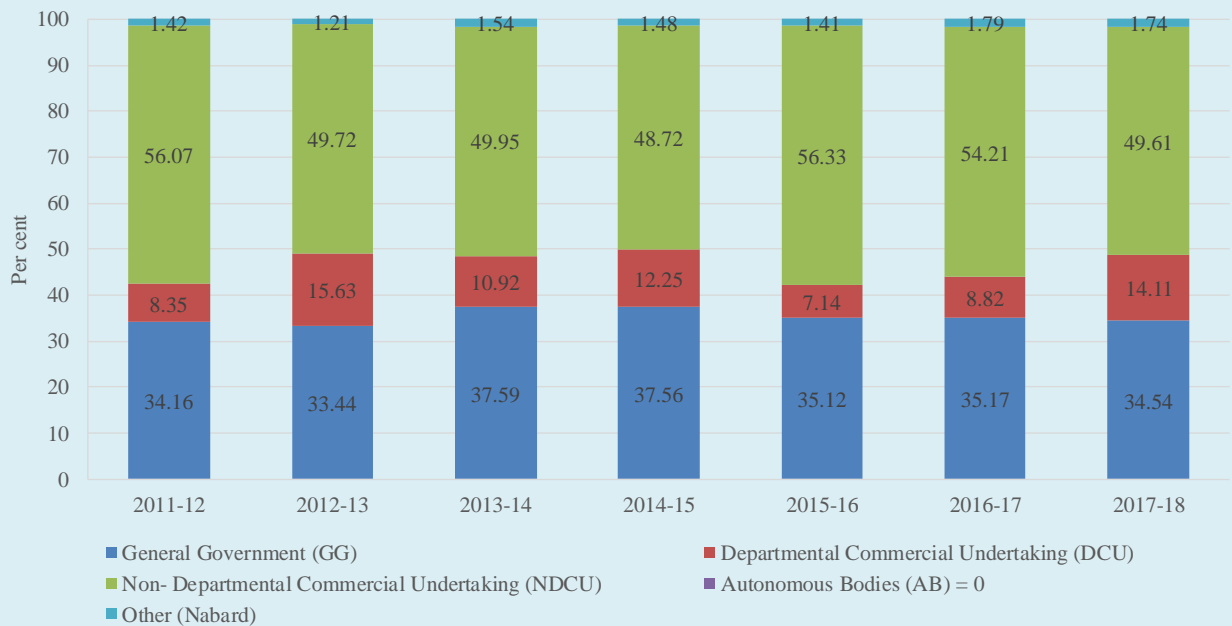
Graph-8: Growth Rate of GFCF



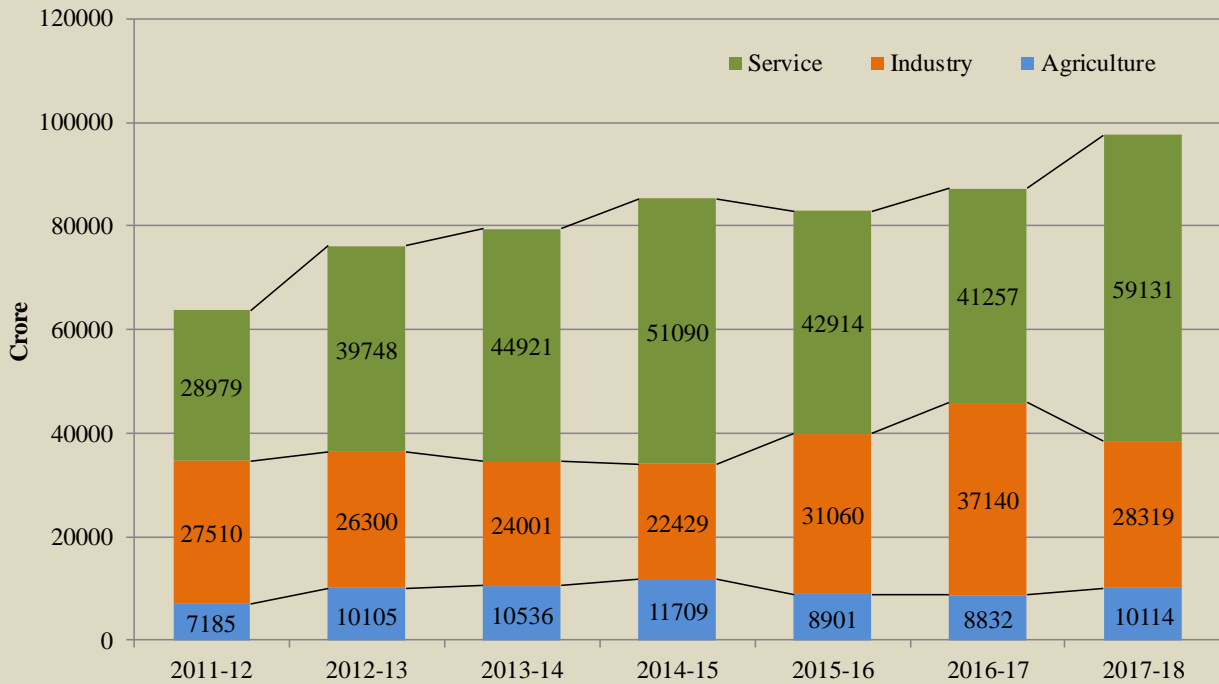
Graph-9: Share of Gross Fixed Capital Formation of Public Sector by type of Assets



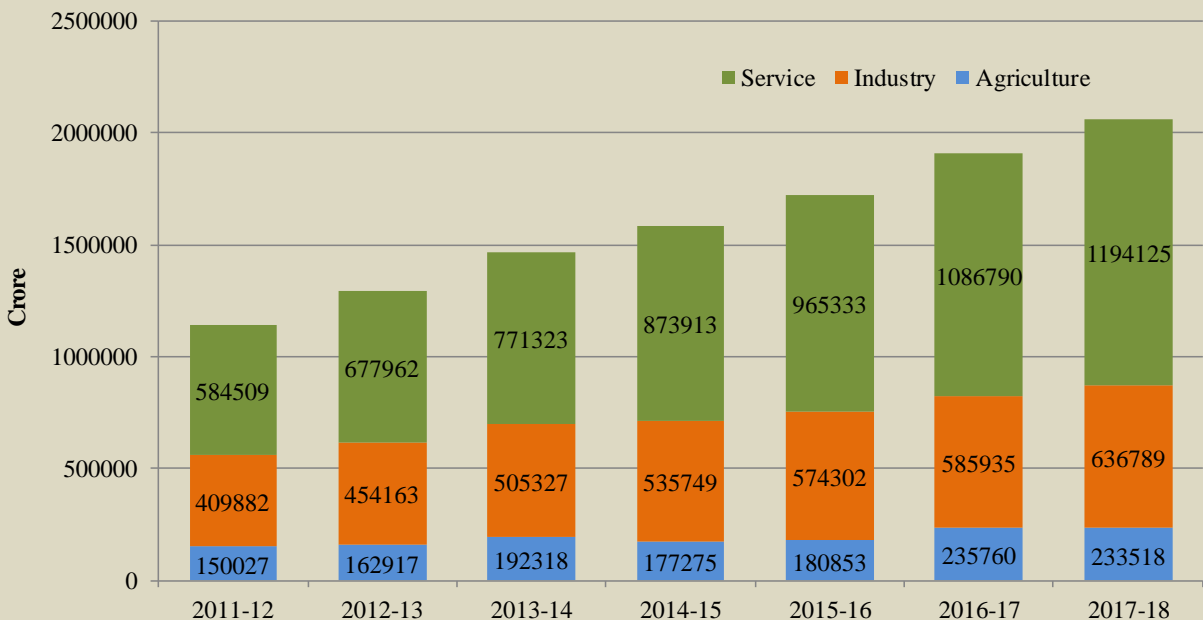
Graph-10: Share of Gross Fixed Capital Formation of Public Sectors Type of Institution
